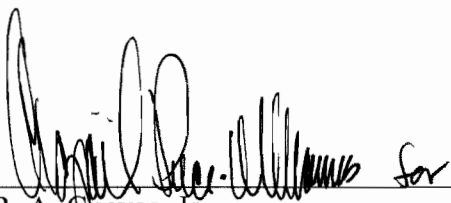

RESOLUTION NO. R-883-08

RESOLUTION APPROVING SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION TO BUILDING BETTER COMMUNITIES GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND PROGRAM PROJECT NO. 104 – “UNINCORPORATED MUNICIPAL SERVICE AREA – CONTINENTAL PARK” AND TO PROJECT NO. 102 – “UNINCORPORATED MUNICIPAL SERVICE AREA- LEISURE LAKES PARK,” AS IDENTIFIED IN APPENDIX A TO RESOLUTION NO. 913-04 AFTER A PUBLIC HEARING

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 913-04 (the “Parks Facility Resolution”), the voters approved the issuance of general obligation bonds in a principal amount not to exceed \$680,258,000 to construct and improve neighborhood parks and other recreational areas; and

WHEREAS, Appendix A to the Parks Facility Resolution lists projects eligible for funding from the Building Better Communities General Obligation Bond Program (the “BBC Program”) by project number, municipal project location, BCC district, project name, project description, street address, and project funding allocation; and

WHEREAS, one of the projects listed in Appendix A to the Parks Facility Resolution and approved by the voters for funding is Project No. 104 – “Unincorporated Municipal Service Area – Continental Park” (“Project No. 104”), located in BCC District 8, with an original allocation equal to \$1 million and a project description that states: “[l]ocal park improvements include building expansion and playground replacement”; and

WHEREAS, another of the projects listed in Appendix A to the Parks Facility Resolution and approved by the voters for funding is Project No. 102 – “Unincorporated Municipal Service Area – Leisure Lakes Park” (“Project No. 102”), located in BCC District 8,

with an original allocation equal to \$600,000 and a project description that states: “[l]ocal park improvements include building renovations”; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the local park improvements that were needed at Continental Park have been completed with other sources of funding; and

WHEREAS, Leisure Lakes Park is within an underserved area with a very active afterschool program and serves as a Children’s Trust Program site; and

WHEREAS, the building at Leisure Lakes Park is aging and undersized, and Leisure Lakes Park is in dire need of additional funding for the immediate renovation, expansion, and improvements to the park and building; and

WHEREAS, all additions, deletions and significant modifications to individual projects or to Appendix A to the Parks Facility Resolution require a majority vote of the Board after a public hearing; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to approve a significant modification to Project No. 104 to decrease the original allocation by \$675,000, for a new allocation of \$325,000; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to approve a significant modification to Project No. 102 to increase the original allocation by the \$675,000 of the Building Better Communities General Obligation Bond funds originally allocated to Project No. 104, for a new allocation of \$1.275 million,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. This Board approves the significant modification to Project No. 104 to decrease the allocation by \$675,000. Accordingly, the column titled "Allocation (000's)" in Appendix A to the Parks Facility Resolution shall read "\$325" with respect to Project No. 104.

Section 3. This Board approves the significant modification to Project No. 102 to increase the allocation by \$675,000. Accordingly, the column titled "Allocation (000's)" in Appendix A to the Parks Facility Resolution shall read "\$1,275" with respect to Project No. 102.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Katy Sorenson.

It was offered by Commissioner **Katy Sorenson**, who

moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner **Joe A. Martinez**
