**CLERK'S SUMMARY AND OFFICIAL MINUTES
NARANJA LAKES
COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY (CRA)
OCTOBER 23, 2006**

The Naranja Lakes Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) Board met in the South Dade Government Center, Room 203, 10710 S.W. 211 Street, Miami, Florida, at 6:00 p.m., October 23, 2006; there being present upon roll call: Mr. Rene Infante, Mr. Daniel Lipe, Mr. Moe Hakssa, Mr. Stuart Archer, Mr. Kenneth Forbes, Ms. Marlene Volkert, (Chairperson Nina Betancourt and Mr. Parsuram Ramkissoon were late); Mr. Mike Iturrey, Budget Coordinator, Office of Strategic Business Management; Mr. Alberto Gonzalez, CRA Analyst, Office of Strategic Business Management; and Deputy Clerk Jill Thornton.

I. Call to Order

Mr. Forbes called the CRA Board meeting to order at 6:08 p.m.

II. Roll Call

Upon roll call and a quorum being present, the Board proceeded to consider tonight's agenda.

III. Approval of the Minutes

It was moved by Ms. Volkert that the September 11, 2006 NLCRA meeting minutes be approved. This motion was seconded by Mr. Lipe and upon being put to a vote, passed unanimously by those members present.

IV. Approval of the Agenda

Mr. Iturrey requested a discussion item regarding Office of Community and Economic Development (OCED) recaptured dollars be added to the agenda, under New Business.

It was moved by Ms. Volkert that the agenda for tonight's meeting (10/23) be approved with the added discussion item, as requested by Mr. Iturrey. This motion was seconded by Mr. Lipe, and upon being put to a vote, passed unanimously by those members present.

V. Old Business

Community Policing Initiative

A. MOU update

Mr. Iturrey noted he possessed the finalized Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) signed by Assistant Director James Loftus, Miami-Dade Police Department, that needed to be signed by the CRA Chairperson. He further noted the community policing initiatives had begun and suggested a format be developed for future Community Policing Initiatives progress reports to be submitted monthly by the Police Department.

Mr. Iturrey presented the following proposed resolution to approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU):

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE NARANJA LAKES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE NARANJA LAKES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CHARIPERSON TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING; AUTHORIZING STAFF TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITONS OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

It was moved by Mr. Forbes that the foregoing resolution be approved, as presented. This motion was seconded by Ms. Volkert, and upon being put to a vote, passed unanimously by those members present.

B. Police Operations update

Sergeant Ozzie Hernandez, Miami Dade Police Department, Cutler Ridge District, provided an update on Security in the Naranja area. He displayed a file kept by the Police Department for accountability purposes to the CRA that summarized policing activities performed, hours worked and arrest results. He noted only Community Service Officers were used for the initiatives and that this month's initiative report documented 494 Field Interview (FI) written reports, 282 citizen contacts and 101 business contacts.

Sergeant Hernandez noted that after surveys were conducted on the older communities, it was determined that both Waterside and Sea Pines communities had insufficient street lighting. He noted Florida Power and Light (FPL) was responsible for fixing Waterside's lighting and some on County property in the Sea Pines Community, but the Sea Pines Homeowners Association owned the majority of light poles in their community and was responsible for fixing those lights. He noted FPL would assure that lights worked properly if the malfunction was due to electrical wiring leading to the lights but Sea Pines would be responsible for contacting FPL and bearing the cost to fix and shade the light bulbs, except those on county properties.

Sergeant Hernandez noted other quality of life issues within these areas included dumped vehicles, furniture, appliances and other junk. He noted Team Metro was contacted to conduct a sweep of the areas and had found in some cases, that a particular house could not be cited in the Sea Pines community because some items were on County property. He expressed the importance of cleaning up these areas to have an atmosphere conducive to the CRA's goals.

Regarding the Roving Patrol Guidelines, Sergeant Hernandez noted the goal was to provide the CRA with what they asked for: high visibility, maintaining patrol in the area, and accountability. He stated that assigned officers were informed of the privileges and expectations relating to the

enhanced enforcement positions and that officers would be removed from the list should they not perform to expectations.

Chairperson Betancourt questioned the difference in the level of criminal activity in the CRA district compared to the entire South Dade District.

Sergeant Hernandez noted that prior to implementing the policing initiatives, robbery was the biggest issue in the CRA district and enforcement was done only along the US 1 corridor. He noted that once operations were set up and hotspots determined, coverage increased, tips resulted from the community, and people felt more secure as a result of police saturation. He further noted that crime tended to decrease when officers became familiar with the community. He suggested the next step would be to do a community event with the police to bring the community together.

Responding to Mr. Archer's inquiry as to whether D.R. Horton provided a map of Mandarin Lakes to the Police Department that referenced those houses occupied versus those awaiting closing, Mr. Herman noted he had already sent one map and could provide another.

Mr. Hakssa and Mr. Ramkissoon commented they had observed a significant increase in police coverage in the area and noticed the results. Mr. Hakssa commended the police department for their efforts.

Sergeant Hernandez noted the first decoy operation for prostitution and solicitation was conducted and arrests were made, which were very effective at getting the prostitutes to leave the area.

In response to Chairperson Betancourt's request for clarification on whether the 494 field interviews included the 282 citizen contacts, Sergeant Hernandez noted that some were inclusive and some were exclusive.

Mr. Archer questioned whether communities could request assistance from the CRA that had problems funding the replacement of busted shields for lights in their area.

Chairperson Betancourt noted this might be an issue the CRA could address through its grants program, since health and safety were top priorities of that program.

Mr. Iturrey requested Sergeant Hernandez provide the monthly policing initiative report to the CRA members one week in advance of every CRA meeting.

Heritage Village Update

Mr. Iturrey provided an update report on the Heritage Village project. He noted he contacted Mr. Stebbins, GSA Construction Manager, to request an assessment report listing needed repairs at the Heritage Village units, which Mr. Stebbins provided, and identifying AC units, windows and the roof in need of repair. Mr. Iturrey noted the General Service Administration (GSA) had begun the bid process for the roof repair work and the bid opening was scheduled for October 31, 2006. Mr. Iturrey noted that Mr. Stebbins indicated he believed the units would be available for occupancy within four to six months.

Mr. Archer pointed out that Mr. Stebbins stated in his presentation at the September 11th CRA meeting, that these units would be ready for occupancy within 90 days.

Mr. Forbes noted the County paid a large sum of money for this particular project which had gone through a number of non-performing contractors and he did not want to see any former contractors bid for the completion of this project.

Chairperson Betancourt asked whether a mechanism existed to identify those individuals or organizations that had abused the process by unjustly profiting from this project.

Mr. Iturrey noted he was uncertain whether all companies related to this project had been identified as non-performing and whether it was being investigated along with Miami-Dade Housing Authority's (MDHA) cases, but he and staff would endeavor to protect the CRA from entering into a contract with a non-performing vendor. He stated he could convey the CRA's concerns to Ms. Cynthia Curry, Senior Advisor to the County Manager, regarding a lack of progress on contracts relating to the Heritage Village project.

Chairperson Betancourt asked if a list could be provided to the CRA, prior to the October 31st bid opening, identifying those contractors to whom funds were allocated from the MDHA for the Heritage Village project. She asked that this list include any non-performing contractors and those who recently bid for the roof repair. She asked to what extent the CRA could get involved with the bid process.

Mr. Ramkissoon commented that Mr. Stebbins was informed at the September CRA meeting that this building was painted while mold and mildew were still visible on the walls and that he identified the main cause for the delay in making these units ready for occupancy was the need to upgrade the AC units.

Mr. Iturrey noted the inspection for mold and mildew would have been the project manager's responsibility.

Mr. Infante asked if a GSA representative could attend a CRA meeting to inform the CRA members on how the procurement process worked.

Mr. Archer directed staff to research the accountability of the funding provided for the Heritage Village project to see whether a criminal investigation by the Inspector General (IG) and the State Attorney's Office was warranted.

Discussion was interrupted to allow Mr. Leonard Anthony to address the CRA.

Mr. Leonard Anthony, Naranja Lakes Condo No. 5 Complex, appeared before the CRA and noted he wanted to address some issues with the CRA tonight but needed to leave the meeting early to attend to a personal matter.

Following Chairperson Betancourt's explanation of why the Board agreed to move agenda Item "Open Forum for Public Comments" to the end of the agenda, the Board continued its discussion regarding the Heritage Village project.

Chairperson Betancourt noted the upcoming bid opening was the pressing issue and that Mr. Iturrey needed to research this issue and provide the CRA members with a list of contractors who were awarded contracts, how much they were paid for this project, and which ones were non-performing. She suggested Mr. Iturrey work closely with Mr. Forbes on obtaining this information.

Mr. Iturrey noted he was certain he could provide a list of individuals who obtained a bid packet from the Public Works Department for the roof repair, but was not certain he could provide a list of those individuals who actually bid on the project.

Mr. Steve Zelkowitz, Legal Counsel for the CRA, advised that a bid packet contained a number of questions that addressed disbarment and the county's disbarment process disqualified those companies that were non-performing from the bid process. He also advised that it was difficult for an outside Board to influence the decisions in the GSA's process.

Mr. Iturrey stated he would have a GSA representative present at the next CRA meeting to address the procurement process.

The CRA directed Mr. Iturrey to report to Ms. Cynthia Curry regarding their concerns on the Heritage Village project as it related to the amount of funding spent, the length of the project and the contractor's performance.

Illegal Dumping Enforcement Update

Ms. Francie Boellard, Neighborhood Compliance Supervisor, Team Metro South, provided a status report on illegal dumping in the CRA district. She explained the process for citing illegal dumping once the 311 call center received a call. She noted that if the Police Illegal Dumping Unit could not identify the offender, the case would be referred to Team Metro for dumping that occurred on private property and to the Department of Solid Waste (DSW) for dumping that occurred on a public right-of-way. Concerning private properties, she noted, the property owner was usually cited by Team Metro because the owner was ultimately responsible for maintaining his/her land.

In response to Chairperson Betancourt's question concerning whether most of the dumping activities were done by the homeless, Ms. Boellard noted most activities were probably due to laziness and improper disposal of waste materials.

Mr. Archer commented that more cooperation was needed between governmental agencies and Team Metro concerning illegal dumping. He noted the need to pick up the trash, especially on the public right-of-ways.

Ms. Boellard noted Team Metro tries to work with DSW but ultimately DSW was responsible for dealing with the public right-of-ways. She noted the 311 Call Center was set up to expedite this process.

Chairperson Betancourt pointed out the amount of time to navigate through the County agencies could be a problem.

Sergeant Hernandez advised that he would contact Mr. Robert Baras to schedule a cleanup of the area using workers needing to perform community service hours. He noted he would make the community policing officers aware of the problem, as well.

Mr. Ramkissoon suggested a DSW representative be present at the next CRA meeting to address these issues with this Board.

In response to Mr. Archer's comments regarding his previous request that staff address the issue of debris along SW 280 ST and SW 145 Avenue, which had not been removed yet, Ms. Boellard stated this roadway was inspected by Team Metro and referred to DSW since it was on public property.

Ms. Boellard advised that Team Metro officers were proactively working in the CRA district to address illegal dumping, but it was an ongoing battle. She advised that several junk-n-trash cases were identified and that the Sunrise Trailer Park at SW 145 Avenue and 280 Street was in the process of removing all junk trailers from the park. Regarding vacant private property, Ms. Boellard noted a due process needed to be followed that often resulted in a time delay before any action could be taken. She noted two vacant parcels owned by Miami Dade County Library and Parks & Recreation Department were in violation and referred to GSA, and that a warning was issued to a property at SW 152 Avenue and 280 Street for a chain link fence in disrepair, but no remediation process for fixing a fence. She noted some violations could be remediated but others must follow the due process with a proper warning given.

Mr. Archer stated he was aware that some of those properties cited were owned by Mr. George DeGuardiola and asked what the CRA could do to help resolve this problem.

Mr. Iturrey stated he was scheduled to meet with Mr. DeGuardiola on unrelated issues and that he would inform him of these problems and report back to the CRA regarding the outcome. He asked that Ms. Boellard provide him with all information concerning any property owned by Mr. DeGuardiola

Ms. Boellard noted Team Metro granted an extension to the privately-owned property west of the lot owned by the Parks and Recreation Department, for the repair of a chain-linked fence and that Team Metro works with all property owners who make an effort to comply, but cannot take action against the government-owned properties.

Mr. Iturrey pointed out that the report indicated that governmental agencies responded to the citations placed on the County-owned properties and those lots were cleaned up and the repairs made. He noted he would work with Team Metro and contact the appropriate departments should further problems exist.

Mr. Hakssa stated he observed County staff repairing the fence but the lots had not yet been cleared of the junk.

Mr. Forbes questioned the status of the proposal presented to the CRA by Mr. DeGuardiola regarding land owned by the County and a joint venture project for a library, park and housing. He noted a discussion was needed with the County Commission and Mr. DeGuardiola regarding the status of this project.

Mr. Iturrey stated he would research the status of the subject project and report back to the CRA with an answer.

Update on Mandarin Lakes

Mr. Paul Herman, Development Project Manager, D.R. Horton Builders, provided an update on sales of the Mandarin Lakes Homes. He noted a total of 400 units had been sold to date, which included 207 town homes, 120 forty-foot single family homes and 78 fifty-foot single family homes; and that 85 town homes, 45 forty-foot single family homes and 28 fifty-foot single family homes had closed. He noted 840 permits were issued, which included everything east of the C103 canal.

In response to Mr. Archer's question regarding the crime status in the Mandarin Lakes area, Mr. Herman stated he was unaware of any major occurrences that had taken place since the last CRA meeting.

Chairperson Betancourt stated she felt it was important that the marketing staff for the Mandarin Lakes Homes be apprised of the policing initiative.

Mr. Herman advised that D.R. Horton Builders and Naranja Lakes Construction, LLC were in the process of finalizing a security program and that it was just a matter of how it would be subsidized.

Mr. Joe Gaudi commended the Police Department for a job well done on the policing initiative. He noted he observed more coverage and police presence in the community and that the homeowners felt safer.

In response to Mr. Lipe's question regarding whether negative sales were indicative of the overall real estate market, Mr. Herman stated it was due to a combination of things, but the market was a major part of it. He noted a lot of people had dropped out at closing due to the HOA's restricted covenants and investors getting cold feet. He also noted the media has had a negative effect on the real estate market.

In response to Chairperson Betancourt's question regarding what type of incentives were currently being offered that were not offered a year ago, Mr. Herman noted upgraded kitchens, flooring, appliance packages and various color selections.

In response to Ms. Volkert's question regarding a time line for completing the Mandarin Lakes Club House, Mr. Herman advised that the tract of land for the park had been cleared and was now ready for permitting and that he recently received the final revisions back from Miami-Dade County Building Department.

Update on Infrastructure Project

Mr. Luis Carbonelle, Naranja Lakes Construction, LLC, provided an update on the infrastructure project. He noted utility lines for phases two and three had been conveyed and were awaiting an administrative release for use. He further noted the irrigation permit had been approved by the Building Department but a hold was placed by DPW, that requested a consumptive use permit. He noted as soon as this was completed, the installation of irrigation and landscaping would proceed and would take approximately five weeks to complete. Following completion of landscaping and

irrigation, the final layer of asphalt would be installed. Regarding the Civic Center Plaza, he noted the permits came back with comments, and as soon as they were addressed by the contractor and the permits approved, the project could proceed.

In response to Mr. Archer's question concerning the completion of converting SW 140th Avenue into a four lane roadway, Mr. Carbonelle noted he spoke with a DPW inspector who stated his concern with the southern portion of SW140th Avenue that turned into SW 280th Street and led to a bridge had not been widened to four lanes yet.

Mr. Iturrey noted he mentioned the CRA's concerns to Mr. Luis Carbonelle but noted the CRA directed that the final lift of asphalt not be placed until the heavy equipment used to install the trees in the medium had left the area, in order to prevent any damage to the roadway.

Mr. Carbonelle noted DPW was responsible for constructing the bridge and if they agreed to maintain the traffic, then the bridge could be opened.

Mr. Forbes stated he would rely on the project manager's report.

Mr. Ritsema, Project Manager, noted he met with the traffic division of DPW and the School Board and that DPW stated they wanted to keep the eastern lanes two-way and leave the western lanes for school pickup and drop off only and not open the rest of the roadway. He noted that there was no traffic capacity problem and it would be safer to keep traffic on the east side of the medium. He also noted Solo Construction was not doing a great job of maintaining signage.

In response to Mr. Infante's question regarding a time frame for completion of the bridge, Mr. Carbonelle noted the bridge would be completed in phase two of the project.

Mr. Iturrey noted he met with all concerned parties several times concerning this project and obtained a solid commitment from Mr. DeGuardiola that phase one would be completed. He noted he was hopeful that phase one would be completed by the end of the year and that he understood phase two was bid on but not yet awarded. Mr. Iturrey advised that several items in the amended development agreement needed to be addressed and that he would try to develop a comprehensive report outlining which projects were completed and which needed to be completed pursuant to the agreement, and what positions were taken by each concerned party. He stated he wanted the report to specifically reflect the project's progress rather than a matching percentage equaling a percentage of funds allocated and disbursed.

In response to Mr. Archer's question regarding that starting date for the proposed project that was presented to the CRA by the Parks and Recreation Department some time ago, Mr. Iturrey stated staff would research this project and report back to the CRA on its status.

VI. New Business

List of Businesses in the CRA

Chairperson Betancourt noted the provided List of Businesses showed some of the occupational licenses listed as multiple licenses under one entity, and that there were a number of entities duplicated.

In response to Mr. Infante's question regarding whether this list reflected businesses currently operating in the CRA district, Mr. Iturrey noted these were active occupational licenses in the CRA district. He stated he could break the list down and report back on the number of duplicates.

Mr. Archer suggested the list also provide the total number of people employed within these businesses, which might help to foster additional businesses and employment.

Chairperson Betancourt suggested this information be placed in an electronic format for when a mailing list was developed. She also suggested that the Naranja Area Businesses (NAB) Concept mail a survey inquiring of the number of people employed within these businesses.

Mr. Hakssa noted the CRA needed to understand the reasons behind the closing of businesses within the CRA district.

Chairperson Betancourt stated she had asked repeatedly that property records be flagged to alert the CRA of a permit or zoning application submitted for a property located within the CRA district rather than hear about a public hearing in a local periodical.

Mr. Forbes noted that the Planning & Zoning Department cross referenced their files and sends out a radius letter when applications came in.

Mr. Ramkissoon stated he had inquired about what was being developed on the two properties across from the Winn Dixie Plaza but no one seemed to know what they were designated for. He noted all properties needed to be flagged as soon as development began.

Mr. Forbes indicated that the properties at SW 286th Street and 153rd avenue had been platted for twenty-two homes to be built by Habitat for Humanity.

Mr. Iturrey noted folios were already flagged for properties in the area to determine the Tax Increment and staff could always provide a mailer informing property owners of the CRA. He noted he would meet with the appropriate departments (Building, P&Z, and PW) to determine the best approach for sharing this information, and he would provide a report at the next CRA meeting.

Recapture of OCED dollars

Mr. Iturrey advised that a CRA member discovered in a newspaper article that funding was allocated to the NLCRA from Katy Sorenson's Commission District 2003 Discretionary funds for economic development and that OCED was considering recapturing and reallocating this funding. He noted had he been aware of the availability of this funding, he would have included it in the budget. Mr. Iturrey advised that he was currently in discussions with OCED's Director regarding the CRA's ability to retain this funding and to learn of its history. He stated if the Board desired, he would report to the Director and the County Manager that the CRA would like to retain this funding.

Chairperson Betancourt asked if amendments would be considered at the public hearing scheduled before for the November 17th Community Empowerment Economic Revitalization Committee (CEERC) meeting prior to any final action entered by the BCC.

Mr. Iturrey noted he was not sure whether this item would go before the CEERC again. He stated he would recommend these funds be used to supplement the CRA's proposed grant programs.

Mr. Ramkissoon noted he did not recall any discussion by this Board regarding funds requested from any Commissioner and noted the CRA was unaware that these funds existed.

Discussion ensued regarding the funding source, the requestor, and the purpose.

Mr. Steve Zelkowitz, Legal Counsel for the CRA, mentioned he believed he saw a reference in the newspaper regarding an allocation to the NLCRA this year from the County under some grant program and that staff needed to check with the County regarding other funding sources that came out this year as well.

Mr. Iturrey noted, as part of their procedures, OCED was responsible for issuing notice whenever they recaptured funds. He stated he would research all these issues with the Director of OCED and report back to the CRA on his findings.

Mr. Forbes asked that Mr. Iturrey check all subsequent years, as well.

Following the discussion, it was moved by Mr. Forbes that Mr. Infante be identified as the NLCRA's representative to go before the Board of County Commissioners on this matter, if needed. This motion was seconded by Mr. Hakssa, and upon being put to a vote, passed unanimously by those members present.

Mr. Iturrey stated he would meet with the OCED Director regarding these matters prior to going before the BCC and that he would ask to be provided with a report of all funding awarded to the NLCRA since its inception.

VII. Open Forum for Public Comments

Chairperson Betancourt opened the floor for public comments.

Mr. Joe Gaudi appeared before the CRA and suggested the CRA require that contractors bidding on the Heritage Village project be required to place a performance bond.

Mr. Zelkowitz advised that any past or future development agreement with the CRA would include a bond requirement.

Mr. Phillip Murray, 13248 SW 156 Terrace, appeared before the CRA and questioned the amount of recaptured dollars and the funding source. He also expressed concern with the Field Interviews conducted by the Police Department, noting he had a problem with police officers stopping individuals walking through a community to gather personal information on them without a specific purpose. He asked whether the CRA had requested the Police Department to provide an ethnic/age breakdown on the FIs that justified safety rather than profiling.

Mr. Iturrey responded that the \$70,000 were recaptured from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).

Mr. Forbes responded that the CRA trusted the ability and professionalism of Law Enforcement to do their job according to the policies and procedures in place and did not require an ethnic/age breakdown, only a report of services performed in accordance with funds allocated. He noted all information was available to the public in public records and he supported the Police Department since he had seen a great reduction of criminal activity in the community as a result of implementing the policing initiatives.

Mr. Murray noted this meeting was not well attended by African Americans and that he would like to think that this Board represented the interests of everyone in the community.

Mr. Forbes noted he was very active in this community and had good relationships with all of its ethnic groups. He noted the CRA did not see any issues but wanted the perpetrators gone regardless of ethnicity.

Chairperson Betancourt noted this was a publicly advertised meeting and the entire community was welcomed to attend. She noted the CRA appreciated the comments from the public.

Mr. Darryl Christians appeared before the CRA and commended the Police Department for a great job in securing the Sea Pines Community and making the people feel safe.

In response to Chairperson Betancourt's question regarding the lighting situation in the Sea Pines community, Mr. Christians noted he spoke with an FPL representative who advised that the old light bulbs were 100 watts and could be converted to a cap 400 watt that would provide better lighting. He noted additional poles were not needed just better lighting by changing the heads of the lights.

Sergeant Hernandez advised that he observed some 400 watt lights in the entrance way of Sea Pines community. He noted it was just a matter of updating the wiring, if needed.


Mr. Joe Gaudi stated he could assist in directing Mr. Christians to the right sources to correct the lighting issue.

III. Setting of next Meeting Date

Chairperson Betancourt announced that the next NLCRA meeting would be held on November 27, 2006 at 6:00 p.m. and that the Agenda Item "Open Forum for Public Comments" would remain at the end of the agenda for the time being.

VIII. Adjournment

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

Naranja Lakes CRA Initiative
Monthly Progress Report

Date of report: October 23, 2006

The following is a synopsis of the police enforcement and community policing actions provided to the Naranja Lakes CRA boundaries from September 26, 2006 to Sunday October 22, 2006:

- At the onset of the initiative an up to date analysis was conducted of the areas of concern to determine the most active days and hours of the week to provide the most efficient coverage.
- A Roving Patrol Guidelines flyer was developed to provide specific directions to the officers working the detail as to what is expected of them and provide guidance as to their responsibilities.
- Following a meeting with the Sea Pines Association, a flyer was prepared for distribution to officers working the detail to make them aware of citizen concerns directed at specific criminal activity.
- After patrolling and surveying the areas, it was determined that the Sea Pine Community and the Waterside Community required a Team Metro Sweep to address Quality of Life concerns. The sweep produced the following:

A sweep was conducted with the following results:

28112 SW 143 Court – A warning was issued for a junk car.


28216 SW 143 Court – The green commercial truck is permitted per the by-laws of the association.

28331 SW 141 Place – A warning was issued for a broken fence.

28130 SW 141 Place – A warning was issued for a broken fence.

- Due to lighting concerns within Waterside and Sea Pines Community, a FPL survey sweep was conducted with CRT and FPL management. The sweep located 10 lights within the Waterside Community that were non functional or had been vandalized. The Sea Pine Community produced 7 lights that were non functional or vandalized. Some lights were marked to be modified with a protection to prevent future damage.
- A total of 36 four hour roving patrols were conducted during this month period and 8 four hour squad details. Their enforcement efforts produced the following:

1. A total of 17 arrests, from which 12 were warrant arrests conducted upon stopping and running a records check on an individual. One arrest was of a female prostitute who had a probation violation



warrant from her prior arrest during a CRA prostitution sweep. In addition, 1 felony, 2 Misdemeanor arrests, and 2 traffic arrests.

2. A total of 63 traffic citations were issued.
3. A total of 13 message recoveries were affected, 12 persons and 1 vehicle which was a recovered stolen vehicle.
4. A total of 494 Field Interview Reports were written by officers who conducted a stop of an individual who warranted concerns to document his information for future reference.
5. A total of 34 career criminals were stopped and documented.
6. A total of 494 citizen contacts were initiative and 101 business contacts.

In addition to the listed actions, on 10/18/06, roving patrol located a stolen occupied vehicle which was driving throughout and casing the Mandarin Lakes Development. The driver was apprehended and the vehicle recovered.

On 10/20/06, while conducting a burglary operation in the area by officers who normally work the CRA details, an armed carjacking subject was located and arrested in the victim's vehicle within the Waterside Community. Although officers were not working their normal CRA detail, their commitment to patrol this CRA area due to their newly developed bonds with this community guided their actions to enforce this area.


NARANJA LAKES CRA INITIATIVE

ROVING PATROL GUIDELINES

As of September 26, 2006, in a coordinated effort between CRT and the Naranja CRA board, funds have been approved for up to one year of enhanced overtime enforcement within the CRA boundaries. The boundaries are from SW 268 Street to SW 288 Street, from South Dixie Hwy to the Florida Turnpike. The initiative is on a production basis and requires monthly and/or weekly presentations of statistical and community productivity. As such, this detail requires a proactive officer who is self-initiative and community oriented. The following are some guidelines to assist officers in understanding what is expected of them on these details:

- High Visibility Patrol: Must be in uniform and in a marked police unit
- Community Interaction: Roving officer should interact with the neighborhood he is patrolling. Since the detail is also community policing guided, we want the officers to get to know the residences.
- Remain in your Patrol Area: Since the details are only four hours, officers are to be self sufficient to allow them to conduct continues patrol, remaining within the CRA boundaries.
- Radio Procedures: The officers will check in on the radio taking a 13-signal reference Naranja CRA detail and provide their duty hours. If the officer has to leave for some unexpected reason, provide details on your worksheet along with times and location of change.
- Calls for Service: Officer working this detail will not handle calls for service in their assigned area. They will however respond as an assisting backup unit and interact with the citizens at the scene. **Officers must remain in their assigned area** unless an emergency backup request of an incident in an adjacent to the CRA boundaries is requested. Remember, the CRA is a private funding on an overtime basis to provide personalized patrolling.
- Worksheets: Officer will complete a worksheet for every detail worked. The original worksheet will be provided to CRT Sergeant Ozzie Hernandez at the Hainlin Mills Office who is the project manager and will maintain statistical totals for presentation to the CRA Board. Officers will attach a copy of their worksheet to their overtime slip for Faith Wyant in the payroll section.
- Overtime Slip: Will be completed, one per detail and must be for overtime only. Under the reason section, the officer will write “ **Naranja CRA Charge Back code #TFNARANJALAK**”. The O.T. slip has to be turned in along with its attachments by no later then the next working day to maintain budget accuracy.
- Arrest Forms: Copies of all arrest forms have to be attached with the original worksheet that will be provided to Sergeant Hernandez.

Just a reminder that this operation is a privilege and if abused may be terminated. Officers participating will be selected and can be removed for the eligibility list if they fail to perform as requested.

RESOLUTION OF THE OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE NARANJA LAKES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE NARANJA LAKES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND THE MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRPERSON TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING; AUTHORIZING STAFF TO TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY AND APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The Naranja Lakes Community Redevelopment District ("NLCRD") geographic area is generally described as being from Southwest 268 Street to Southwest 288 Street, and from Old Dixie Highway to the Florida Turnpike, which area has been experiencing crime trends throughout the NLCRD including robberies, burglaries, prostitution, thefts, and other crimes of opportunity; and

WHEREAS, in order to address these crime trends the NLCRA has requested that an enforcement initiative be implemented by the Miami-Dade Police Department ("MDPD") to combat the crime trends within the NLCRD; and

WHEREAS, MDPD has agreed to implement the requested enforcement initiative pursuant to and in accordance with the terms and provisions of the Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference made a part hereof; and


WHEREAS, the Naranja Lakes Community Redevelopment Agency ("NLCRA") desires to enter into the MOU with the MPDP for the purposes stated therein.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT
AND
NARANJA LAKES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY**

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (this "MOU") is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 2006, by and between the **MIAMI-DADE POLICE DEPARTMENT** ("MDPD") and the **NARANJA LAKES COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY**, a public body corporate and politic ("NLCRA").

RECITALS

1. The Naranja Lakes Community Redevelopment District (NLCRD) geographic area is generally described as being from Southwest 268 Street to Southwest 288 Street, and from Old Dixie Highway to the Florida Turnpike, which area has been experiencing crime trends throughout the NLCRD including robberies, burglaries, prostitution, thefts, and other crimes of opportunity.

2. To address these crime trends the NLCRA has requested that an enforcement initiative be implemented by the MDPD to combat the crime trends within the NLCRD.

3. MDPD has agreed to implement the requested enforcement initiative pursuant to and in accordance with the terms and provisions of this MOU which represents the mutual understanding of the parties. These initiatives will be funded by the NLCRA and conducted by the MDPD on an overtime basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, in respect of the mutual promises contained herein, the MDPD and the NLCRA agree as follows:

1. PURPOSE

This MOU between the MDPD and the NLCRA was developed in the spirit of mutual cooperation, pursuant to a request for additional law enforcement efforts made by the NLCRA Board. Its purpose is to provide a plan of action for specific and coordinated community-based law enforcement initiatives within the target area boundaries of the NLCRA, specifically the NLCRD, that are in addition to the police services currently provided on a daily basis by on-duty personnel. All operations conducted as part of this plan will be carried out in an overtime capacity, utilizing police personnel from the Cutler Ridge District Neighborhood Policing Unit, the Community Response Team, and other personnel from the MDPD. The initiatives will be funded by the NLCRA through reimbursement as provided herein.

2. ENFORCEMENT STRATEGIES

MDPD shall utilize a variety of community-based law enforcement strategies to facilitate the attainment of the operational goal. The strategies outlined below will be guided using the statistical analysis of ongoing crime trends within the NLCRD, and input of the NLCRA Board.

Staff from Cutler Ridge District's Community Response Team or Neighborhood Policing Unit will attend NLCRA Board meetings to seek their input, and to provide NLCRA Board Members with an update of ongoing policing efforts. The additional law enforcement efforts provided by MDPD will consist primarily of the following types of details:

2.1. Operational Sweeps: Operational Sweeps consist of one (1) sergeant and four (4) police officers, targeting specific crime trends in the NLCRD utilizing proactive law enforcement operation techniques. Operational Sweeps will last four hours, at an estimated average cost of \$ 1,198* per operation.

2.2. Roving Patrol: Roving Patrols consist of one (1) uniformed police officer with a marked police vehicle providing high-visibility patrol. This officer will interact with members of the community to facilitate the building of a partnership between the community and law enforcement. Roving Patrols will last four hours, at an estimated average cost of \$224* per operation.

2.3. Community Oriented Policing Details: Community Oriented Policing Details to include but not be limited to, community outreach to residents, businesses and community partnerships; will consist of one (1) sergeant and four (4) police officers addressing community concerns by utilizing the Community Policing philosophy, rather than a traditional policing strategy. Community Oriented Policing Details will last four hours, at an estimated average cost of \$1,796* per operation.

3. STATISTICAL TRACKING AND REPORTING

3.1. Upon the commencement of this MOU, the MDPD through its Cutler Ridge District Crime Analysis Unit (CAU) will conduct an updated base-line grid analysis of the targeted crime trends within the NLCRD. This intelligence information will be utilized to effectively determine the most efficient hours of operation for the Specialized Law Enforcement Details, as described in Section 2 above. Staff from Cutler Ridge District's Community Response Team or Neighborhood Policing Unit will attend NLCRA Board meetings to seek their input, and to provide NLCRA Board Members with an update of ongoing policing efforts.

3.2. At the conclusion of the term of this MOU, MDPD will conduct a follow-up grid analysis of the targeted crime trends within the NLCRD. MDPD will then complete a comparison of the base-line and follow-up grid analysis reports. Additionally, MDPD will provide to the NLCRA for its review a combined total of all activities for all the operations.

3.3. Cutler Ridge District staff will maintain a file, available for inspection by the NLCRA Board and staff, containing copies of all Daily Activity Reports, Arrest Affidavits, and Daily Productivity Reports completed in connection with this MOU.

4. FUNDING

The NLCRA will reimburse MDPD for the direct cost of each individual law enforcement detail conducted as part of this operation. The total reimbursements for all details conducted by MDPD shall not exceed \$10,000 in FY 05-06, and \$255,000 in FY 06-07, absent

further agreement by the parties. As a condition of reimbursement, MDPD shall provide the NLCRA with a Reimbursement Report for each law enforcement detail conducted as part of this operation on a monthly basis, enumerating the number, type and cost of the details conducted along with such other information as may be reasonably requested by the NLCRA in support of the requested reimbursement.

5. LIABILITY

To the extent permitted by law and as limited by Section 768.28, Florida Statutes, the MDPD shall assume the liability arising from acts taken by its personnel pursuant to this MOU. In no event shall a party be liable for acts, omissions, or conduct of the officers, employees or agents of the other participating party of this MOU.

6. EFFECTIVE AND TERMINATION DATE

This MOU becomes effective upon the signature by both parties, and will remain in force until September 30, 2007, unless extended or terminated sooner as provided herein. This MOU can be extended for a longer period of time upon the mutual agreement of both parties; however, such agreement shall be in writing and signed by both parties. The MOU can also be terminated by either party, with or without cause, by giving written notice to the other party in accordance with Section 7.7 below. In case of cancellation, the NLCRA agrees to reimburse MDPD only for overtime actually accrued for services performed prior to the date of cancellation.

7. MISCELLANEOUS

7.1. Headings; Recitals. The headings of the sections of this MOU are for convenience only and do not affect meanings of any provisions hereof. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporated herein by this reference.

7.2. Amendment. The terms, covenants, conditions and provisions of this MOU cannot be altered, changed, modified or added to, except in writing signed by the MDPD and the NLCRA and approved by the NLCRA Board.

7.3. Third Party Beneficiaries. Neither of the parties intend to directly nor substantially benefit any third party by this MOU. Therefore, the parties agree that there are no third party beneficiaries to this MOU and that no third party shall be entitled to assert a claim against either of them based upon this MOU.

7.4. Waiver. No express or implied consent or waiver by a party to or of any breach or default by the other party in the performance by such other party of its obligations under this MOU will be deemed or construed to be a consent or waiver to or of any other breach or default in the performance by such other party of the same or any other obligations of such other party hereunder. Failure by a party to complain of any act or failure to act of the other party or to declare the other party in default, irrespective of how long such failure continues will not constitute a waiver by such party of its rights hereunder. The giving of consent by a party in any one instance will not limit or waive the necessity to obtain such party's consent in any future instance.

7.5. Independent Contractor. In performing its obligations hereunder, the MDPD shall be deemed an independent contractor and not an agent or employee of the NLCRA.

7.6. Assignment. Neither this MOU, nor any interest herein, shall be assigned, transferred by the MDPD without the prior written consent of the NLCRA.

7.7. Notice. Whenever any party desires or is required by this MOU to give notice to the other party, it must be in writing and given by hand, sent by certified mail, with return receipt requested, or sent by a recognized overnight courier (e.g., Federal Express) addressed to the party for whom it is intended, at the address specified for notice by the parties from time to time. Notice may also be given by electronic means (e.g., facsimile or email) provided such is followed up with a hard copy by one of the methods in the previous sentence.



No statements, representations, warranties, either written or oral, from whatever source arising, except as expressly stated in this MOU, shall have any legal validity between the parties or be binding upon any of them. The parties acknowledge that this MOU contains the entire understanding and agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter hereof.
