

## **Naranja Lakes CRA Initiative** **Monthly Progress Report**

The following is a synopsis of the police enforcement and community policing actions provided to the Naranja Lakes CRA boundaries from Monday, January 17, 2011 to Sunday, February 20, 2011:

- At the onset of the initiative, an up to date analysis was conducted of the areas of concern to determine the most active days and hours of the week to provide the most efficient coverage.
- A total of 56 four-hour roving patrols details and 10 enforcement sweeps were conducted during this monthly period as an initiative. As a result, the initiative produced the following totals:
  1. A total of 27 arrests/apprehensions were made of which 9 felony, 2 misdemeanors, 10 warrants, and 6 traffic arrests.
  2. A 9mm auto handgun was seized from a convicted felon.
  3. A total of 146 traffic citations (85 H MV, 61 N H MV, and 14 V/W).
  4. A total of 10 person's message recoveries.
  5. A total of 453 Field Interview Reports were written by officers who conducted a stop of an individual who warranted concerns to document there information for future reference.
  6. A total of 16 crack cocaine rocks, 6 grams of cocaine, 17 grams of marijuana, 300 baggies, 2 crack pipes, and 4 Zany Bars were seized.
  7. A total of 72 career criminals were stopped and documented.
  8. A total of 495 citizen contacts were initiative and 76 business contacts.

### **Enforcement Highlights:**

On January 21, 2011, a CRA unit arrested a convicted felon loitering in the area in possession of a stolen 9mm auto handgun fully loaded. Investigation revealed the handgun had been stolen in an armed robbery in the City of Homestead.

On February 2, 2011, the sweep units apprehended a wanted fugitive who had an outstanding warrant for aggravated battery and possession of a firearm by a convicted felon. The fugitive had been eluding arrest for over 30 years and was homeless.

On February 4, 2011, a CRA roving unit apprehended a drug dealer within the Waterside community in possession of 14 grams of marijuana, 300 baggies, and a narcotics scale.
