

Naranja Lakes CRA Initiative
Monthly Progress Report

The following is a synopsis of the police enforcement and community policing actions provided to the Naranja Lakes CRA boundaries from Monday, May 16, 2011 to Sunday, June 19, 2011:

- At the onset of the initiative, an up to date analysis was conducted of the areas of concern to determine the most active days and hours of the week to provide the most efficient coverage.
- A total of 44 four-hour roving patrols details and 10 enforcement sweeps were conducted during this monthly period as an initiative. As a result, the initiative produced the following totals:
 1. A total of 18 arrests/apprehensions were made of which 2 felony arrests, 9 warrant arrests, 5 traffic arrests, and 2 misdemeanor arrests.
 2. A total of 192 traffic citations (119 HVM, 69HVM, & 4 Parking).
 3. A total of 9 person's message recoveries.
 4. A total of 2 Civil Trespassing Violations.
 5. A total of 248 Field Interview Reports were written by officers who conducted a stop of an individual who warranted concerns to document there information for future reference.
 6. A total of 3 grams of marijuana were seized.
 7. A recovery of a boat and trailer valued at \$8,400.
 8. A total of 49 career criminals were stopped and documented.
 9. A total of 391 citizen contacts were initiative and 84 business contacts.

Enforcement Highlights:

A wanted fugitive from Henry County was apprehended during a roving patrol.

Community Highlights:

As of to date, the Police Explorer Youth program has successfully recruited 7 kids from within the CRA community through their weekly meetings at the CRA building. We are also receiving regular requests from other CRA kids and their parents to join; however, they were below the 14 year requirement age.
