

Naranja Lakes CRA Initiative
Monthly Progress Report

The following is a synopsis of the police enforcement and community policing actions provided to the Naranja Lakes CRA boundaries from Monday, June 20, 2011 to Sunday, July 17, 2011:

- At the onset of the initiative, an up to date analysis was conducted of the areas of concern to determine the most active days and hours of the week to provide the most efficient coverage.
- A total of 39 four-hour roving patrols details and 9 enforcement sweeps were conducted during this monthly period as an initiative. As a result, the initiative produced the following totals:
 1. A total of 12 arrests/apprehensions were made of which 3 felony arrests, 2 misdemeanor arrests, 7 warrant arrests, and 0 traffic arrests.
 2. A total of 169 traffic citations (76 HVM, 93 HVM, & 0 Parking).
 3. A total of 7 person's message recoveries.
 4. A total of 227 Field Interview Reports were written by officers who conducted a stop of an individual who warranted concerns to document there information for future reference.
 5. A total of 1 gram of cocaine was seized.
 6. A total of 2 grams of marijuana was seized.
 7. A total of 28 career criminals were stopped and documented.
 8. A total of 150 citizen contacts were initiative and 26 business contacts.
