Robert Kirshbaum distributed the Sunshine Review questionnaire which must be completed by end of year. The questionnaire covers BGMAC meetings from 12/05 through 12/06. The report must also include record of attendance of BGMAC members and community attendance.

Vernell Everett distributed copies of letters sent out to managers of several municipalities requesting their input on the incorporation process. He stated that corresponding with other municipalities will show that BGMAC is actively gathering necessary information.

Robert Kirshbaum stated that revision of UMSA may end up having the BGMAC owing the county. The status of BG could change from a recipient to a donor community. He also noted that the county has instituted a 3 year phase out for the mitigation fee which could also benefit the BGMAC process.

Vernell Everett provided update on BCC proposal to take over the affordable housing work force committee. This may mean that zoning issues would be taken from the community counsel and a special committee would be formed.

Ann Cates wanted to know the deadline for the Sunshine Review Report. Mr. Kirschbaum stated that he would be able to provide most of the information except the attendance for MAC members and community involvement.
