Meeting called to order by chair Vernell Everett.

Ann Cates to wanted know if Robert Kirschbaum had a chance to review new numbers on the impact to UMSA. Mr. Kirschbaum stated that he only has the old numbers. The format is not yet complete. As soon as format is updated he will forward the information to Roger Gordon. He also stated that the format for the police department will be updated. The specialized police service fee is being phased out over a 3 year period beginning this year.

BGMAC reviewed and approved the Sunshine Review Questionnaire. The questionnaire covers issues addressed and accomplishment by the BGMAC such as:

- exploring the feasibility of successfully operating as a city
- Serving the community's need through educating the public about the pros and con of incorporation.
- Gathered information on all county departments such as Police, Fire, solid waste etc. Educated the BGMAC/ public on municipal services, drafted a budget and completed comparative analysis.
