

MPO RESOLUTION #07-09

RESOLUTION DIRECTING STAFF TO PREPARE A SCOPE OF WORK AND BUDGET FOR A STUDY TO EVALUATE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IN THE PROXIMITY OF MAJOR PARKS IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, pedestrian safety around the parks in Miami-Dade County is a concern; and

WHEREAS, roadway projects in the proximity of major parks have presented pedestrian safety issues to patrons of the parks; and

WHEREAS, at the December 18, 2009 MPO Board meeting, Board Member Javier D. Souto requested staff to evaluate this issue further,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BOARD OF THE METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION FOR THE MIAMI URBANIZED AREA, that the MPO staff is directed to prepare a scope of work and budget for a study to evaluate pedestrian safety in the proximity of major parks in Miami-Dade County.
