**Title:** FEE SCHEDULE FOR THE MIAMI-DADE FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT TRAINING FACILITY

**AUTHORITY:**

Sections 4.02 of the Code of Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter.

**POLICY:**

This Implementing Order provides a schedule of fees for services, programs, and facility rental provided or operated by the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

**PROCEDURE:**

The administration of this Implementing Order is designated to the Director, Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, who will be responsible for the collection of fees and the delivery of the required services. The Director shall review the contents of the implementing order annually and, if appropriate, make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners for revisions or adjustments.

**FEE SCHEDULE:**

The fee schedule adopted by this Implementing Order is attached hereto and made a part hereof. This official fee schedule is also filed with and subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners and on file with the Clerk thereof. Fees charged by the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department shall be the same as those listed in the official fee schedule on file with the Clerk of the County Commission. The Director may, at his discretion, waive fees associated with the implementing order. Written requests to waive fees must be received at least 30 days prior to the training date.

User fees for members of the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners are hereby waived.
