Title: FEE FOR MIAMI-DADE FIRE RESCUE JUNIOR LIFEGUARD PROGRAM

Ordered: 9/22/2016

Effective: 10/1/2016

AUTHORITY:

Sections 1.01 and 2.02A of the Miami-Dade County Home Rule Charter and Article XXI, Section 2-182 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

POLICY:

This Implementing Order provides a fee for the Junior Lifeguard Program operated by the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

PROCEDURE:

The administration of this Implementing Order is designated to the Fire Chief, Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, who will be responsible for the collection of fees and the delivery of the required services pursuant to Article XXI, Section 2-182 relating to the powers and duties of the Fire Department. Every year, or earlier, if necessary, the Fire Chief shall review the fees in terms of cost and may recommend changes to the Mayor through this implementing order procedure.

FEE SCHEDULE:

The fee for the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Junior Lifeguard Program shall be \$200 per participant. This official fee is also filed with and subject to the approval of the Board of County Commissioners and on file with the Clerk thereof. Fees charged by the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department shall be the same as those listed in the official fee schedule on file with the Clerk of the County Commission.
