| Notes | The proposed resolution authorizes the execution of a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) |
| Notes | between Miami-Dade County (County) and the City of Florida City (City) to reimburse the City for the construction of a road improvement project along SW 344 Street from US-1 to SW 172 Avenue (Project). |
| | The City is currently working with developers along SW 344 Street in order to bring commercial developments in the area. SW 344 Street is currently a four lane roadway divided by a canal. There is a concern about traffic access and flow that is limited by the canal. Therefore, the City is proposing to culvert the existing canal in order to add lanes and provide better access to the area. The City is providing the design of the Project at its sole expense. |
| | Background On April 12, 2016, the City Commission adopted Resolution No. 16-19, approving this JPA. The City will implement a Public Involvement Plan (PIP) to provide information to property owners, tenants and area residents for major work to be performed in the area. Construction of the improvements is scheduled to commence in April 2017. |
| | <u>Fiscal Impact</u> The construction cost estimate for the Project is \$5,073,744.26. This JPA provides partial |
| | funding for the construction of the Project. Thus the County will provide up to \$3,100,000 from Road Impact Fee District 6 funds. The balance of the Project's construction costs will be provided by the City. |
