**SUBJECT:** Review of Boards and Councils; Second Follow-up Report

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On June 21, 2007, the Governmental Operations and Environment Committee (GOE) Sunset Review of County Boards Workshop indicated a desire for an update to our Review of Boards and Councils Report dated March 31, 2006 and our Follow-up Report dated November 30, 2006. Staff was also tasked with collecting other data.

We have concluded our update and submit this Second Follow-up Report, which contains updated information on Boards' vacancies, meeting frequency, quorum attainment, and other data. Our previous Follow-up Report, dated March 31, 2006, had already updated the data through the end of FY 2005-06. This Second Follow-up Report provides data for the first and second quarters of FY 2006-07.

We conducted limited testing of information provided to us by Staff, and we found no reason to doubt the accuracy of the reported data. The data in this Second Follow-up Report showed: (1) no significant changes in the percentage of Boards with high vacancy rates and/or low quorum achievement rates, and (2) an improvement in the number of Boards that had met during the period. The updated data continues to support the findings and recommendations in our previous reports. Attachment 1 summarizes key data and provides comparisons with our previous follow-up report. Attachment 2 provides board-by-board data and comparisons for each of the 106 Boards we surveyed.

We thank the employees of the County Manager's Office, departments and agencies, and the Clerk of the Board for their cooperation in this follow-up and throughout our review. Please let me know if you need further information.

## Attachment 1

### SUMMARY RESULTS

Our review of 106 Boards showed that:

- The County Boards and Appointment System (CBAS) showed a net reduction of 5 Boards in “active status” since our previous follow-up report.

⇒ 4 boards were added to active status in CBAS since the previous review:

1. Charter Review Task Force
2. Community Action Agency
3. Crane and Heavy Equipment Advisory Committee
4. Health Facilities Authority

⇒ 9 boards were removed from active status in CBAS since the previous review:

1. Affirmative Action Advisory Board
2. Biscayne National Park Buffer Development Review Committee
3. Flood Management Task Force
4. Governmental Structure Task Force
5. Mitigation Adjustment Policy Review Task Force
6. Opa-locka Airport Development Task Force
7. Procurement Reform Advisory Board
8. South Miami-Dade Watershed Plan Advisory Committee
9. Trauma Advisory Board

⇒ In CBAS, the Community Councils are covered in one entry. Counting each of the ten (10) Community Councils as a separate Board, brought the total number of Miami-Dade County Boards to 106, as of June 30, 2007. [Note: Community Councils were the subject of a review conducted by the Miami-Dade County Office of the Inspector General (OIG) and the OIG report issued on February 7, 2005.]

⇒ For our report, the ten (10) Community Councils were counted individually.

- The five (5) boards listed below did not meet during the period under review:
  1. Citizens’ Independent Transportation Trust Nominating Committee
  2. Enterprise Zone Advisory Council
  3. Goulds Area Municipal Advisory Committee
  4. PLANT (Princeton, Leisure City, and Naranja) Area Municipal Advisory Committee
  5. The Community Improvement Authority has not met since approximately 2002 but was created pursuant to and continues to exist in Florida Statutes, Chapter 189.
- The Miami-Dade County Commission on Ethics and Public Trust is a Miami-Dade County Department; therefore it was not included in this review.

## Attachment 1

The Aircraft Noise Abatement Task Force for Miami International Airport and Aircraft Noise Abatement Task Force for Opa-Locka Airport are technically sunsetted. However, they continue to meet, are listed as active boards in CBAS, and the Board Secretary indicated that legislation was in preparation to reconstitute their roles. The Aircraft Noise Abatement Task Force for Miami International Airport was not created by ordinance.

- The Racial Profiling Advisory Board is technically sunsetted but is classified as an active board in the CBAS. It was not created by ordinance.
- The Charter Review Task Force is a new board – no information is available for the period under review.
- The following boards did not respond or provide information to our request:
  1. Crane and Heavy Equipment Advisory Committee
  2. Metro Miami Action Plan Trust Nominating Council
  3. Public Health Trust
  4. Public Health Trust / Miami-Dade County Annual Operating Agreement Committee
  5. Public Health Trust / University of Miami Annual Agreement Negotiating Committee
  6. Public Health Trust Compensation and Evaluation Committee
  7. Public Health Trust Nominating Council
  8. The Children’s Trust. (The Children’s Trust declined to provide data, citing their status as an independent special taxing district under Florida Statutes.)
