Pursuant to Resolution R-96-05 (attached), staff prepared the following information on vacancies through the end of the second quarter of FY 2009-10.

The total cost of the positions as shown in this report reflects the cost of salaries and fringes for a full fiscal year. However, this cost does not take into account the value of the natural or budgeted attrition built into the department's budget, in addition to the implementation of departmental saving plan initiatives which had the effect of freezing 146 positions. Therefore, in most cases, no savings could be realized if these positions were to be eliminated.
