Mr. Marvin Aronoff addressed the committee advising them that he took a four(4) hour Fire Stoppage class but is unable to find the certificate. Subcommittee suggested to Mr Aronoff that he appear at the Board of Rules and Appeals meeting on Thursday, February 15, 2001.

Mr. Nariman Balsara addressed the committee advising them that he got certified late in the year (July 2000) and thought he was not expected to fulfill the 16 hours of continuing education, a misunderstanding on his part. Mr. Gonzalez informed Mr. Balsara that he is in violation of South Florida Building Code the same code that he is enforcing. Subcommittee suggested to Mr. Balsara that he appear at the Board of Rules and Appeals meeting on Thursday, February 15, 2001.

Mr. Joseph Carpenter addressed the committee advising them that he attended a two(2) day class but did not get credit for the second day eight(8) hours because he may have failed to sign-in. Mr. Velazquez advised that the same rule applies here as with a Contractor that is also an inspector for a municipality. The rule being that the contractor cannot contract in the municipality for which he is doing inspections. After some discussion, the committee stated that a recommendation would be made to the Board of Rules and Appeals on Thursday, February 15, 2001 to restrict Mr. Alvarez's certification.

Mr. Oriol T. Haage, Building Code Compliance Specialist, briefly brought to the subcommittee's attention issues regarding the certification of Roy Van Wyk and his review of bus shelter plans in 1991. The subcommittee acknowledged this discussion as informational and recommended that it should be presented to the Board of Rules and Appeals on Thursday, February 15, 2001.
