Result: Mr. Daniel Vuelta, Contractor Enforcement Section Supervisor, confirmed the qualifying agent's address, as called by the Recording Secretary. The Respondent and Staff were sworn in by the Court Reporter at 9:30 A.M. Benjamin Simon, Assistant County Attorney, provided the procedural structure of the Formal Hearing process.

Mr. Vuelta informed the Board that the case being brought to them was in regards to a Contractor completing the job for reroofing the condominium located at 1135 SW 6 Street. Upon the completion of the job, the property owner informed Mr. Vuelta that he started having a leak in two of the apartments.

Mr. Francisco Arechaga, Contractor Enforcement Investigator, notified the Board that he discovered that the roof had irregularities and the Respondent sent a representative to inspect if the leaks were coming from the roof. Mr. Arechaga informed the Board that a permit was obtained by the contractor and the final inspection was passed with the City of Miami. Mr.

Arechaga also informed the Board that the Qualifying Agent hired a private consultant to conduct testing and verify that the reroof work was up to code.

Mr. William Lopez, Homeowner’s Representative, affirmed to the Board that the Contract on Page 12-16 is the one he signed and paid in full to Roche Roofing, Inc. Mr. Lopez informed the Board Members that the Respondent didn’t fulfill Page 19 of the Contract. The Complainant notified the Board that the gutters are damaged.

Mr. Faustino Roche informed the Board that the consultant he hired recommended additional drainage on the Northeast side of the building. He clarified that he got in contact with the Homeowner’s representative to investigate whether the leak was coming from the walls prior to getting notified of the complaint. Mr. Roche informed the Board that the leak might be coming from the exterior wall or windows which he noticed was painted recently. Mr. Roche insisted that the leaks are not coming from the roof. He advised that upon completion of the flood tests, the results came back negative for leaks from the roof.

Upon further discussion, Mr. Robert Baer moved to **defer** Mr. Roche’s Formal Hearing to the next CTQB meeting of February 26th, 2014, to allow the respondent to meet with Staff and the private consultant on testing of the roof. Mr. James Rose seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.

the cabinet doors, the hardware installation, and the vanity mirror. Ms. Benjamin informed the Board that Ms. Garcia noticed that hardware installation was not evenly spaced. The investigator spoke with the Contractor and sent a response via email of a photo of the installation without the hardware. The contractor responded that the work was installed according to the Contract.

Mr. Julio Sosa testified on behalf of the complainant and informed the Board that they are not satisfied with the quality of the work performed by Mr. Gonzalez. Mr. Sosa notified the Board that the faucets are not evenly spaced.

Upon further discussion, Mr. Robert Baer rendered that no further action shall be taken and there would be **No Formal Hearing** scheduled at this time given that issue were related to workmanship. Mr. James Rose seconded the motion. The **motion carried unanimously**.
