SUBJECT: Board of Rules and Appeals Interpretation-

Miami-Dade County Chapter 8, Article II - Field Experience

At their meeting of April 18th, 2013, the Board of Rules and Appeals (BORA) considered an interpretation of Miami Dade County Chapter 8, Article II regarding field experience. The question addressed by the Board was whether the field experience obtained in Broward by an applicant for BORA certification can qualify the individual for the Electrical, Mechanical and Plumbing Inspectors and Residential Plans Examiners.

Upon further review of the Code provisions, the Board interpreted that:

The five years of field experience obtained under Broward County licensure with license reciprocation does qualify for the five years of field experience required for Board of Rules and Appeals certification as Electrical, Mechanical and Plumbing Inspectors and Residential Plans Examiners.
