- 4.5 Nailing shall be in compliance with Detail "B", attached.



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5. LABELING:


- 5.1 Shingles shall be labeled with the Miami-Dade Logo or the wording "Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved"

6. BUILDING PERMIT REQUIREMENTS:


- 6.1 Application for building permit shall be accompanied by copies of the following:
