APPROVED ASSEMBLY:

SYSTEM A: Vertical Seam Metal Roof Panel (16" and 12" wide only)
Deck Type: Wood, Non-insulated
Deck Description: New Construction ¹⁹/₃₂" or greater plywood or wood plank.
Slope Range: 2":12" or greater
Maximum Uplift Pressure: See **Table A** Herein

Deck Attachment: Deck shall be attached in accordance with applicable Building Code, but in no case shall it be less than 8d ring shank nails spaced 6" o.c. In reroofing, where the deck is less than ¹⁹/₃₂" thick (Minimum ¹⁵/₃₂") the above attachment method must be in addition to existing attachment.

Underlayment: Minimum underlayment shall be an ASTM D 226 Type II installed with a minimum 4" side-lap and 6" end-laps. Underlayment shall be fastened with corrosion resistant tin-caps and 12 gauge 1 1/4" annular ring-shank nails, spaced 6" o.c. at all laps and two staggered rows 12" o.c. in the field of the roll. Or, any approved underlayment having a current NOA.

Fire Barrier Board: Any approved fire barrier having a current NOA. Or for class A or B fire rating, install minimum 1/4" thick Georgia Pacific "Dens Deck" (with current NOA) or minimum 4mm thick of Tritex, RockRoof (with current NOA) or 5/8" water resistant type X gypsum sheathing with treated core and facer.

Valleys: Valley construction shall be in compliance with Roofing Application Standard RAS 133 and with Metal Sales Manufacturing Corporation's current published installation instructions.

Metal Panels and Accessories: Install the "Vertical Seam Panels" and accessories in compliance with Metal Sales Manufacturing Corporation's current, published installation instructions and details. Flashing, penetrations, valley construction and other details shall be constructed in compliance with the minimum requirements provided in Roofing Application Standards RAS 133.

Panels shall be installed with approved clips (3.5" long x 2" wide x 1.875" tall), attached to substrate with two corrosion resistant #10-12 screws of sufficient length to penetrate through the sheathing a minimum of 3/16", at a maximum spacing listed below in Table A, and at 2" from each end.




SYSTEM LIMITATIONS

1. Fire classification is not part of this acceptance; refer to a current Approved Roofing Materials Directory for fire ratings of this product.
2. The maximum designed pressure limitation listed shall be applicable to all roof pressure zones (i.e. field, perimeters, and corners). Neither rational analysis, nor extrapolation shall be permitted for enhanced fastening at enhanced pressure zones (i.e. perimeters, extended corners and corners). The maximum fastener spacing noted in the "Systems Description" section of this approval shall not be exceeded.
3. Panels shall be roll formed in continuous lengths from eave to ridge. Maximum lengths shall be as described in Roofing Application Standard RAS 133.
4. All panels and clips shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name or logo, city, state and the following statement: "Miami Dade County Product Control Approved".
5. All products listed herein shall have a quality assurance audit in accordance with the Florida Building Code and Rule 9B-72 of the Florida Administrative Code.
