

Deck Attachment: In accordance with applicable Building Code, but in no case shall it be less than 8d ring shank nails spaced 6" o.c. around the perimeter and 6" o.c. in the field. In reroofing, where the deck is less than $1\frac{9}{32}$ " thick (Minimum $1\frac{5}{32}$ ") The above attachment method must be in addition to existing attachment.

Underlayment: Minimum underlayment shall be a ASTM D 226 Type II installed with a minimum 4" side-laps and 6" end-laps. Metal Panels and Accessories: Install the " D.C.S.M. VS 150 Roof Panels " and accessories in compliance with Dan's Custom Sheet Metal, Inc' current, published installation instructions and details. Flashing, penetrations, valley construction and other details shall be constructed in compliance with the minimum requirements provided in Roofing Application Standards RAS 133. Panels shall be attached as follows.

1. At the eave, rake, and ridge, clips shall be located not more than 3" away from the panel end.
2. Panels shall be installed with approved VS SS Clips, attached to substrate with two corrosion resistant #10 FH deck screw of sufficient length to penetrate through the sheathing a minimum of $\frac{3}{16}$ ", at a spacing of 16" o.c. parallel to the roof slope.

System A(2): D.C.S.M. VS 150 Roof Panel
Deck Type: Wood, Non-insulated
Deck Description: Re-Roof only; $1\frac{5}{32}$ " or greater plywood or wood plank.
Slope Range: 2": 12" or greater
Maximum Uplift Pressure: -76.75psf. (See Limitation #2)

Deck Attachment: In accordance with applicable Building Code, but in no case shall it be less than 8d ring shank nails spaced 6" o.c. around the perimeter and 6" o.c. in the field. In reroofing, where the deck is less than $1\frac{9}{32}$ " thick (Minimum $1\frac{5}{32}$ ") The above attachment method must be in addition to existing attachment.

Underlayment: Minimum underlayment shall be a ASTM D 226 Type II installed with a minimum 4" side-laps and 6" end-laps. Underlayment shall be fastened with corrosion resistant tin-caps and $1\frac{1}{4}$ " annular ring-shank nails, spaced 6" o.c. at all laps and two staggered rows 12" o.c. in the field of the roll.

Valleys: Valley construction shall be in compliance with Roofing Application Standard RAS 133 and with Dan's Custom Sheet Metal, Inc.' current published installation instructions.

Fire Barrier Board: Any approved fire barrier having a current NOA. Refer to a current fire directory listing for fire ratings of this roofing system assembly as well as the location of the fire barrier within the assembly. See Limitation # 1.

Metal Panels and Accessories: Install the " D.C.S.M. VS 150 Roof Panels " and accessories in compliance with Dan's Custom Sheet Metal, Inc' current, published installation instructions and details. Flashing, penetrations, valley construction and other details shall be constructed in compliance with the minimum requirements provided in Roofing Application Standards RAS 133. Panels shall be attached as follows.

1. At the eave, rake, and ridge, clips shall be located not more than 2" away from the panel end.
2. Panels shall be installed with approved VS SS Clips, attached to substrate with two corrosion resistant #10 FH deck screw of sufficient length to penetrate through the sheathing a minimum of $\frac{3}{16}$ ", at a spacing of 16" o.c. parallel to the roof slope.



System A(3): D.C.S.M. VS 150 Roof Panel
Deck Type: Wood, Non-insulated
Deck Description: Re-Roof only; ¹⁵/₃₂" or greater plywood or wood plank.
Slope Range: 2": 12" or greater
Maximum Uplift Pressure: See Table 'A' Below

Deck Attachment: In accordance with applicable Building Code, but in no case shall it be less than 8d ring shank nails spaced 6" o.c around the perimeter and 6" o.c. in the field. In reroofing, where the deck is less than ¹⁹/₃₂" thick (Minimum ¹⁵/₃₂"") The above attachment method must be in addition to existing attachment.

Underlayment: Minimum underlayment shall be a ASTM D 226 Type II installed with a minimum 4" side-laps and 6" end-laps. Underlayment shall be fastened with corrosion resistant tin-caps and 1¹/₄" annular ring-shank nails, spaced 6" o.c. at all laps and two staggered rows 12" o.c. in the field of the roll.

Valleys: Valley construction shall be in compliance with Roofing Application Standard RAS 133 and with Dan's Custom Sheet Metal, Inc.' current published installation instructions.

Fire Barrier Board: Any approved fire barrier having a current NOA. Refer to a current fire directory listing for fire ratings of this roofing system assembly as well as the location of the fire barrier within the assembly. See Limitation # 1.

Metal Panels and Accessories: Install the " D.C.S.M. VS 150 Roof Panels " and accessories in compliance with Dan's Custom Sheet Metal, Inc' current, published installation instructions and details. Flashing, penetrations, valley construction and other details shall be constructed in compliance with the minimum requirements provided in Roofing Application Standards RAS 133. Panels shall be attached as follows.

1. At the eave, rake, and ridge, clips shall be located not more than 3" away from the panel end.
2. Panels shall be installed with approved 1500SNS Clips, attached to substrate with two corrosion resistant #12 screws of sufficient length to penetrate through the sheathing a minimum of ³/₁₆", at a maximum spacing as noted below in Table 'A' parallel to the roof slope.
3. Panel ribs shall be fully engaged to form an integral snap-lock.


LIMITATIONS

1. Fire classification is not part of this acceptance; refer to a current Approved Roofing Materials Directory for fire ratings of this product.
2. The maximum designed pressure listed herein shall be applicable to all roof pressure zones (i.e. field, perimeters, and corners). Neither rational analysis, nor extrapolation shall be permitted for enhanced fastening at enhanced pressure zones (i.e. perimeters, extended corners and corners).
3. Panels may be rolls formed in continuous lengths from eave to ridge. Maximum lengths shall be as described in Roofing Application Standard RAS 133
4. All panels shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and the following statement: "Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved" or with the Miami-Dade County Product Control Seal as seen below. All clips shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and/or model.



5. All products listed herein shall have a quality assurance audit in accordance with the Florida Building Code and Rule 61G20-3 of the Florida Administrative Code.




D.C.S.M. VS 150 ROOF PANELS




D.C.S.M. VS SS CLIPS




SYSTEMS A(1) AND A(2)




1500SNS CLIPS
