Trade Name: DECRA Ridge Vent

System Type A: Mechanical attachment of static ridge vent over metal roof panels and under Metal roof ridge

cap.

Installation: 1. Allow a 3" opening centered in the deck at the ridge for ventilation. The slot shall

terminate approximately 12" from the rake edges.

2. Install 2" x 2" wood battens along the ridge. Align the top edge of the battens along the edge of the plywood on both sides of the ridge to expose the attic opening. Measure,

cut, bend, and install the final course of panels.

3. Remove the 1 x 4 spacer and roll out the vent material along the top of the battens. Remove the white paper while unrolling to expose adhesive dots. Apply pressure over

the adhesive dots to hold material in place during installation.

4. Install the DECRA Hip and Ridge Shake over the vent material. Fasten with #9 x 1-

1/2" screws 13" o.c. through the vent material into the battens.

Minimum Slope: 2:12

LIMITATIONS:

1. Refer to applicable Building Code required ventilation.


- 2. DECRA Ridge Vent shall comply with applicable Building Code.
