System:	1-1/2" SnapLock (155 ALLSEAM) - 19" wide panel
Deck Type:	Wood, Non-insulated
Deck Description:	New Construction ¹⁹ / ₃₂ " or greater plywood or wood plank.
Slope Range:	2": 12" or greater
Maximum Uplift Pressure:	See Table A below

Deck Attachment:	In accordance with applicable Building Code, but in no case shall it be less than 8d annular ring shank nails spaced 6" o.c. In reroofing, where the deck is less than ¹⁹ / ₃₂ " thick (Minimum ¹⁵ / ₃₂ ") The above attachment method must be in addition to existing attachment.
Underlayment:	Minimum underlayment shall be an ASTM D 226 Type II installed with a minimum 4" side-lap and 6" end-laps. Underlayment shall be fastened with corrosion resistant tin-caps and 12 gauge 1 1/4" annular ring-shank nails, spaced 6" o.c. at all laps and two staggered rows 12" o.c. in the field of the roll. Or, any approved underlayment having a current NOA.
Fire Barrier Board:	Any approved fire barrier having a current NOA. Refer to a current fire directory listing for fire ratings of this roofing system assembly as well as the location of the fire barrier within the assembly. See Limitation # 1.
Valleys:	Valley construction shall be in compliance with Roofing Application Standard RAS 133 and with the current published installation instructions and details in Metal Alliance, Inc's Installation Manual.
Metal Panels and Accessories:	<p>Install the "1-1/2" SnapLock (155 ALLSEAM) Steel Panel" including flashing penetrations, valleys, end laps and accessories in compliance "Metal Alliance, Inc's" current, published installation instructions and in compliance with the minimum requirements detailed in Roofing Application Standard RAS 133.</p> <p>Panels shall be secured along the male rib with approved clips and two (2) corrosion resistant #10 fasteners of sufficient length to penetrate through the sheathing a minimum of ³/₁₆". The panel clips were placed at a spacing listed in Table A below. The adjacent panel female end is snap fit over the secured panel/clip male assembly.</p>

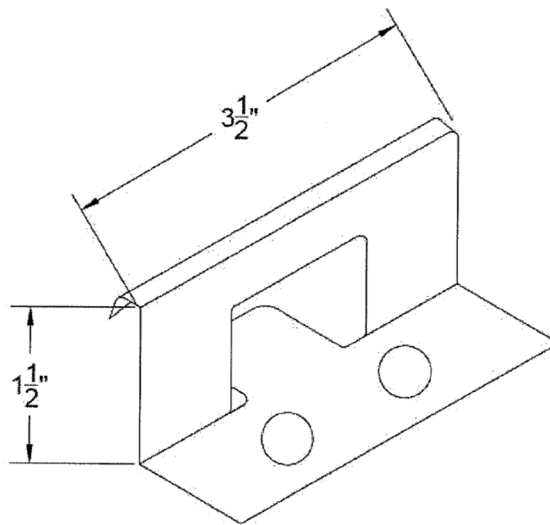
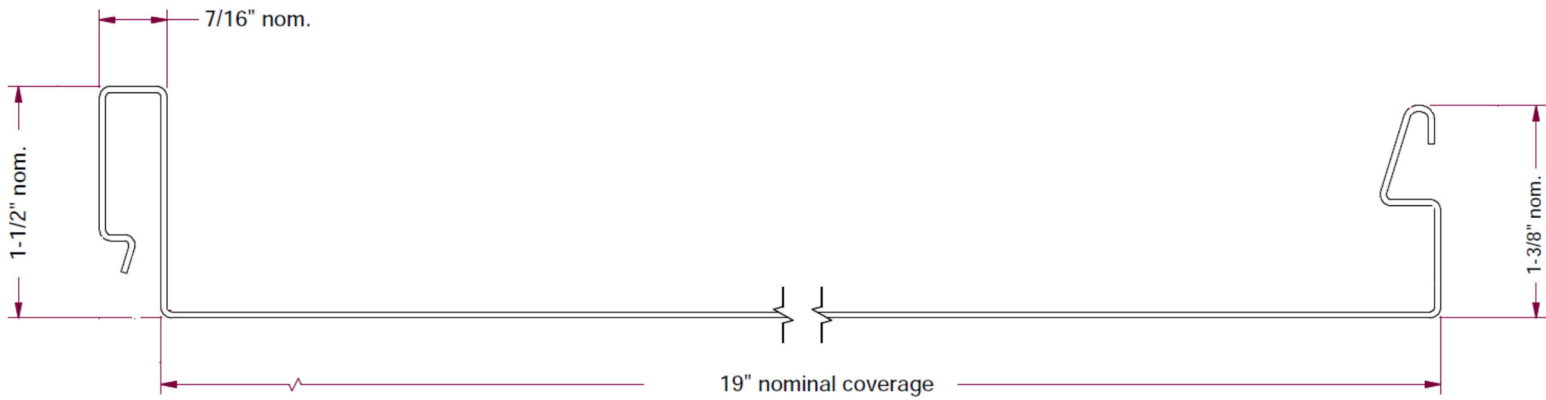
- 1 Fire classification is not part of this acceptance; refer to a current Approved Roofing Materials Directory for fire ratings of this product.

2. Panels may be rolls formed in continuous lengths from eave to ridge. Maximum lengths shall be as described in Roofing Application Standard RAS 133
3. All panels shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and the following statement: "Miami-Dade County Product Control Approved" **or** with the Miami-Dade County Product Control Seal as seen below. All clips shall be permanently labeled with the manufacturer's name and/or logo, and/or model.
