It has come to the attention of the Building Code Compliance Office that the qualifying agent **Robert Smith III** passed away December 6, 2002. Florida State Statute 489.121, states the following:

489.12 Emergency registration upon death of contractor.--If an incomplete contract exists at the time of death of a contractor, the contract may be completed by any person even though not certified or registered. Such person shall notify the board, within 30 days after the death of the contractor, of his or her name and address, knowledge of the contract, and ability to complete it. If the board approves, he or she may proceed with the contract. For purposes of this section, an incomplete contract is one which has been awarded to, or entered into by, the contractor before his or her death, or on which he or she was the low bidder and the contract is subsequently awarded to him or her, regardless of whether any actual work has commenced under the contract before the contractor's death..

Therefore, our Office request that your Department **REFRAIN FROM ISSUING ANY NEW PERMITS UNDER THIS LICENSE.**
