Hello Rodney,

First and foremost I want to express my gratitude for your continuous efforts on understanding and following-up on the City of Miami request for a set-aside waiver (no measures) of the County's S. Miami Ave drainage work established through a City-County JPA. As your aware, the City's intent is to construct these County improvements as part of a larger scale project entitled "Mary Brickell Village Drainage Improvements, B-30637". The nature and extent of the County drainage improvements is significantly less than the City's work (less than 10%). As a result, the City respectfully requests that the CSBE Review Committee understand the main objective which is for the S. Miami Ave drainage work to be advertised by the City under one contract and constructed by one Contractor. The overall drainage improvements that adjoins both County and City streets will resolve or significantly decrease flooding caused by storm events within the project area that are necessary & conducive to public safety, convenience and welfare. As such we feel that a set-aside waiver to the JPA work is the most practical and logical approach that will greatly facilitate the overall City's contract development, construction management efforts and expedite the project timeline.

Should our request not be approved by the CSBE Review Committee, then we will accept set-aside requirements for only the County's S. Miami Ave drainage work under the JPA. The set-aside requirements must not be applied to work proposed on City owned roads to be constructed under the "Mary Brickell Village Drainage Improvements, B-30637".
