RECOMMENDATION

Contracts and Specifications staff has evaluated the subject project and recommends 1.67% for Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) Subcontractor participation, based on the scope of work required to perform construction work on this project. The cost estimate is \$679,850.75. The Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) staff visually confirmed availability of CSBE firms and included PWWM's Project Measure Analysis and Recommendation findings along with other supporting documents for consideration. PWWM staff met with the Small Business Development Division's (SBD) Construction Manager in an effort to seek out additional opportunities for CSBEs. The Community Workforce Program (CWP) is not applicable to this project. PWD received a response from the Geocode System which determined that the work location are not in a Designated Target Area (DTA).

BACKGROUND

Under the direction of the PWWM, improvements are being made to enhance pedestrian safety and accessibility at some of the busiest intersections in Miami-Dade County.

Enhanced pavement markings for pedestrian crosswalks, wheelchair ramps, pedestrian signals, mast arm replacements, traffic signal relocations, improved traffic signal timing and new signs at many of the intersections are among the upgrades now in place. The changes are designed to better integrate motorist and pedestrian activity and to reduce the speed of traffic at intersections where pedestrians cross.

Scope of work

- A. Work under this Contract includes furnishing of all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment and performing all operations required to construct the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents.
- B. Work includes but is not limited to furnishing all supervision, labor, materials, equipment, and tools to perform traffic signal installation including any ancillary work as indicated in the Work Order. Traffic Signalization upgrades includes the installation of Mast Arms, Traffic Controller Assemblies, and milling and resurfacing. Miami Dade County furnishes Mast Arms, anchor bolts and Traffic Controller Assembly. The Contractor shall furnish and install grounding electrodes, conduits, pull boxes, foundations, pedestrian signal heads with push buttons and signs, overhead signs, Internally Illuminated Street Name Signs, mounting hardware, loop assemblies, signal cable. Additional work also includes installation of pedestrian ramps, ground mounted signs, and pavement markings, construction of side walk, curb and gutter, installation of truncated dome, and removing existing signs and traffic signalization devices in conflict with the proposed scope of work.
- C. If any changes are required due to conflict of design and or field conditions, the Engineer will make the final determination.
- D. The Contractor and all subcontractors, under this Contract, are prohibited from performing any work, other than specified in the Contract and/or directed by the Engineer, within the limits of the project site, without prior written notification to the Engineer. This includes any work for private or commercial entities.

CONTRACTOR CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

- A. Contractor Certification:
 - 1. At the time of Bid and pursuant to the requirements of Section 10-3 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida and these Solicitation and Contract Documents, the Bidder must hold a valid, current, and active:
 - a. Certificate of Competency from the County's Construction Trades Qualifying Board as an Electrical Contractor, or
 - b. Certification, as an Electrical Contractor provided by the State of Florida Electrical Contractors' Licensing Board, pursuant to the provisions of Section 489.511 of the Florida Statutes.
 - 2. Pursuant to Section 255.20, Florida Statutes (F.S.) and in lieu of the above, the County may consider a bid from a Bidder that is a duly licensed Contractor in good standing that has been prequalified and considered eligible by the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) under Section 337.14, F.S. and Chapter 14-2, Florida Administrative Code, to perform the work described in the Contract Documents. Contractors seeking consideration under this Paragraph shall submit along with the Bid Documents for review and consideration, current copy (ies) of their FDOT Certificate(s) of Qualification, Certification of Work Underway, and Status of Contract(s) On Hand. Acceptable FDOT prequalification(s) necessary to perform the Work specified in the Contract Documents include the Traffic Signal Work Class.

ADDITIONAL CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS FOR TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES

- A. In addition to the license(s) required of the Contractor, any personnel engaged in installing, modifying, repairing, removing or maintaining traffic signalization, or any other electrical/electronic traffic control device in Miami-Dade County shall:
1. Perform work under the direction of a Master Electrician which has to be present at the job site or be able to respond within 2 hours of notification.
 2. Perform all work under the direct supervision of a Journeyman Electrician that is certified as an International Municipal Signal Association (IMSA) certified Traffic Signal Technician (TST) Level II or Level III. All work related at or pertaining to the controller must be performed by an IMSA certified TST Level II (Field).
- B. The Contractor shall provide the Engineer and the PWD, Traffic Signal & Signs Division (TS&S), 7100 NW 36 Street, Miami, FL 33166, a copy of all of the above licenses and certifications for their company and employees, including a list of their employees assigned to this Project.
- C. The Contractor shall submit a signed affidavit to the PWD affirming that the Contractor and their employees have the proper and valid licenses and certification (County, State, Private or other Government Agency) prior to start of the Work. As need occurs, due to license(s) and certification(s) expiration and/or changes in personnel, the Contractor is required to submit the new documents to the PWD immediately.
- D. All employees of the Contractor or their subcontractors working within the Public Right-of-Way shall have in their possession a wallet size card or a photocopy of their certification(s) or license(s), at all times. Failure to provide said document(s) shall be cause for removal of employee(s) from the work site, issuance of citation(s) and/or entire shutdown of work by the County.

Reason for Recommendation:

This is a single trade project; none of the primary trade related work (Electrical) can be subcontracted in accordance with the recommendation for award of a construction contract pursuant to the MCC/CICC 7360 Program requirements. Additionally, staff has met with the design engineer, construction project manager, and members of the industry and concluded that there is ancillary work required to complete this project which may be subcontracted for CSBE participation. Ancillary work to be performed under this project includes all specialty trade construction trade categories listed under "Area for Possible Measures."

This type of specialized work is not usually associated with small business enterprise firms that are prime contractors. Also, this type of work is highly specialized and requires special equipment that is typically owned and/or leased by the contractor.

Comments:

PWWM solicited for bids under the MCC 7040 Plan-CICC 7040-0/07 Contract and receive bids for RPQ No. 20120012 on February 17, 2012; three bids were received. The low bidder's status is in default with the PWWM and the two remaining bids are at least 50% to 90% above the cost estimate. Consequently, it was in the County's best interest to reject all bids and re-advertise under the subject RPQ No.

Concrete Work:

Additional work that initially appeared available for subcontracting was that related to the use of the concrete. However, after further research by staff it was noted that the industry performs their own concrete work utilizing skilled laborers. The items listed under the category concrete work are incidental to the scope of work to be performed and included on the Bid Form to facilitate payment to the contractor, should those items be needed to complete repairs and/or restoration as a result of damage during construction.
