Description of Project/Bid: Work under this Contract includes furnishing of all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment and performing all operations required to perform traffic signal improvements and installations including any ancillary work. Traffic signalization upgrades include the installation of mast arms, traffic controller assemblies, milling and resurfacing. Contractor to furnish and install grounding electrodes, conduits, pull boxes, foundations, pedestrian signal heads with push buttons and signs, overhead signs, Internally illuminated Street Name Signs, mounting hardware, loop assemblies, and signal cable. Additional work also includes installation of pedestrian ramps, ground mounted signs, pavement markings, construction of side walk, curb and gutter, installation of truncated dome, and removing existing signs and traffic
