Description of Project/Bid: To establish a contract to furnish all supervision, labor, materials, tools, equipment and performing all operations required to construct the Work in accordance with the Contract Documents. Work includes construction of storm-water systems, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, removal and disposal of various existing pavements, the grading and preparation of subgrade, removal and relocation of existing trees, tree roots, debris, clearing and grubbing; adjustment of existing utility valve covers to new finished grade; sodding, signalization, and signage.
