

This is a request for Review Committee (RC) approval of the proposed Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) goal in order to proceed with soil trenching activities under the E09-DERM-01 Professional Services Agreement for the Internal Services Department (ISD), E09-DERM-01 Project #E09-DERM-01-009-CEI, Soil Trenching for Phase II Env. Site Assessment at the Miami-Dade Police Department Simulator, Ammunition, Classroom and Driving Range site located at NW 97 AVE and NW 58 ST, on behalf of the Internal Services Department (ISD)

The subject project consists of digging up to 30 exploratory excavations to determine the presence of solid waste in soils, soil & groundwater sampling, and reporting.

This contract, a work order originating from the E09-DERM-01 Professional Services Agreement, has been assigned to Cherokee Enterprises, Inc. (CEI). The consultant, CEI, is certified in accordance with OSHA standards in Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response, and is therefore qualified to self perform the soil trenching activities which will minimize additional costs of subcontracting such work.

The Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources (RER) staff has evaluated the project and recommends a 0.0% CSBE subcontractor goal for this project (please see attached Analysis for CSBE Goal Recommendation). Based on site history, the potential for contamination exists and therefore any excavation or removal work must be performed by personnel, including subcontractors, that are certified in accordance with OSHA standards in Hazardous Waste Operations and Emergency Response (HAZWOPER); a requirement that the prime contractor meets. Due to the above and the minimal percentage of CSBE related work at 3.91% (\$1,478.40), RER requests an exemption from the requirement to utilize a CSBE subcontractor for this project.


