Work include removal of existing Venturi meter, valves, piping and fittings; demolishing existing concrete vault; furnishing and installing: proposed 48-inch ductile iron pipe and fittings; resilient seated wedge gate valves; new electromagnetic flow meter, access manholes; including installing new electrical piping and wiring as shown on the drawings; restoring the exiting vault walls and hand rails; cleaning, testing and disinfecting the installation; site restoration; and other appurtenant and miscellaneous work for a complete, satisfactory and functional installation
SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS: Prime Contractor must have successfully completed the installation of at least 1,000 feet of 48-inch diameter or larger concrete pressure pipe in the United States. The experience of key senior personnel with other firms may be counted toward the experience requirement, if acceptable to the Engineer.
