



## **REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS ON THE PROPOSED CDBG AMENDMENTS TO THE FY 2001 AND 2003 THROUGH 2006 ACTION PLANS**

Federal regulations governing the CDBG Program funds require that a participating jurisdiction provide citizens with reasonable notice of, and an opportunity to comment on, any substantial amendments to the FY 2001, 2003, 2004, 2005 and FY 2006 Action Plans. CDBG Program: The primary objective of this U.S. HUD Program is the development of viable urban communities characterized by the provision of decent housing, a suitable living environment, and expanding economic opportunities for individuals/households having low-and-moderate incomes. While the CDBG Program's intent is to principally benefit low-and-moderate income persons, each activity must specifically address, at least, one (1) of the following three (3) National Objectives: 1) to benefit low-and moderate-income persons; 2) to aid in the prevention or elimination of slum or blight; and 3) to meet community development needs having a particular urgency. Miami-Dade County's entitlement for FY 2007 is \$18,670,347, with program income projected in the amount of \$400,000, for a total of \$19,070,347. Through this reprogramming of \$15,349,103.99, including \$876,104 of additional FY 2007 CDBG Entitlement from US HUD, Miami-Dade County is proposing to make the amendments and fund initiatives, as indicated in the Exhibits published on Miami-Dade County OCED web site at [www.miamidadegov/ced](http://www.miamidadegov/ced) and made available for review at the office of Community and Economic Development located at 140 West Flagler Street, Suite 1000, Miami, Florida 33156, Monday thru Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. from June 4, 2007 thru July 3, 2007.

A public hearing is scheduled, as part of the Board of County Commissioners Economic Development and Human Services Committee (EDHSC) meeting on Tuesday, June 19, 2007, which will be at 9:30 a.m., in the commission Chamber located on the second level of the Stephen P. Clark Center, 111 NW First Street, Miami, Florida. The public is invited to attend and comment. The purpose of this meeting is to give the public an opportunity to comment on this proposed plan amendment in a Public Hearing. Comments may also be submitted in writing until July 3, 2007 to the attention of Jose Cintron, Director, Miami-Dade County Office of Community and Economic Development, 140 West Flagler Street, Suite 1000, Miami, Florida 33130. Final Action by the Board of County Commissioners is scheduled for Tuesday, July 10, 2007 at 9:30 a.m. in the Commission Chambers.
