Throughout the year, the Office of Community and Economic Development (OCED) holds a series of community meetings in low-to-moderate income neighborhoods throughout the County. Community Advisory Committees (CACs) should be making their CDBG Capital Improvements, Economic Development and Housing allocations.

These meetings allow the community to identify priority needs for Miami-Dade County's 5-year Consolidated Plan. At the July meetings staff will give updates on the development of the **FY 2008-2012** Consolidated Planning Process. The citizen participation plan provides for and encourages citizens to participate in the development of the consolidated plan. Before Miami Dade County adopts the consolidated plan, it will make it available to citizens, public agencies and other interested parties, information that includes the amount of assistance the County expects to receive and the range of activities that may be undertaken, including the estimated amount that will benefit persons of low-and moderate income.

In accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan, the County will consider any comments or views of citizens received in writing, or orally at the public hearings, that will be advertised at a later date, in preparing the final consolidated plan. A summary of these comments or views and a summary of any comments or views not accepted and the reasons therefore, shall be attached to the final consolidated plan.
