REQUEST FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS ON THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY FY 2005 DISASTER RECOVERY INITIATIVE ACTION PLAN

The public is being notified that Miami-Dade County is proposing to make the following plan amendment to its \$22 million allocation as approved by the Board of County Commissioners by Resolution #R-1260-07 dated November 6, 2007. Federal regulations governing the Florida Department of Community Affairs (DCA) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) 2005 Hurricane Disaster Recovery Initiative require that a participating jurisdiction provide citizens with reasonable notice of, and an opportunity to comment on, any substantial amendments to the FY 2005 Disaster Recovery Initiative Action Plan. Through this amendment, \$6.5 million would be reprogrammed for use by qualified agencies to provide disaster recovery relief as a result of Hurricane Wilma in the areas of housing replacement; rehabilitation; repair; hardening and mitigation activities; and infrastructure repair/improvement projects.
