In the Miami Herald of November 9, 2009, a Public meeting was advertized to be held on December 9, 2009, at 9:30 a.m. before the Housing and Community Development Committee (HCDC) in the Board of County Commission Chambers. The purpose of the meeting was to consider the proposed revisions to the "Citizen Participation Plan for the Consolidated Planning Process & Citizen Participation Guidelines for the Department of Housing and Community Development and the Community Action Agency" (the Plan). **This item is being rescheduled to go before the full Board of County Commissioners on December 15, 2009.** The meeting will be held at **9:30 a.m.** in the Board of County Commission Chambers located on the second level of the Stephen P. Clark Center, 111 NW 1st Street, Miami, Florida.
