

Subject: Resolution Authorizing the Conveyance of a Non-Exclusive Perpetual Easement to the State of Florida Department of Transportation for Transportation Purposes across Miami-Dade County-Owned Property Operated by the Department of Transportation and Public Works, known as the Metrorail South Corridor (Folio # 03-4120-000-0031)

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) adopt the attached resolution authorizing the conveyance of a non-exclusive perpetual easement pursuant to Florida Statute Section 125.38 to the State of Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for transportation purposes across Miami-Dade County (County) owned property operated by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW), known as the Metrorail South Corridor (Folio # 03-4120-000-0031), which is adjacent to and west of State Road 5/US Highway - 1/South Dixie Highway in the vicinity of Granada Boulevard; and authorizing the County Mayor or the County's Mayor's designee to exercise any and all rights conferred therein.

SCOPE

The easement is located within Commissioner Xavier L. Suarez's District 7.

FISCAL IMPACT/FUNDING SOURCE

The conveyance of this easement represents no fiscal impact to the County.

TRACK RECORD/MONITOR

The County has previously granted several easements to FDOT. The County and FDOT have benefitted from these transactions, as it is customary and appropriate to grant easements or other types of conveyances when they become public necessities. The person responsible for monitoring this Easement is Froilan I. Baez, Chief of the DTPW's Right of Way, Utilities, and Joint Development Division, DTPW.

BACKGROUND

FDOT has planned several state road safety improvement projects under its current Five Year Work Program. One of these safety improvement projects impacting the Metrorail South Corridor is in the vicinity of US Highway – 1/Soth Dixie Highway and Granada Boulevard, which is to be let as Financial Project ID No. 433490-1-52-01. Included in the construction activities for the project is a new turning lane which will improve the operation of the intersection. FDOT has requested that MDT donate a 7.35 foot strip along the Metrorail right-of-way adjacent to US Highway – 1/ South Dixie Highway for the turning lane. The M-Path at Granada Boulevard will be reconstructed in the area where the easement is needed.

The Metrorail Rapid Transit System - Stage 1 was constructed with 80 percent funds from the Federal Transit Administration (FTA), 10 percent from FDOT, and 10 percent from the County's People Transportation Plan funds. The property has been appraised at approximately \$75,600.00 and the easement will be conveyed with no compensation from FDOT. FDOT will be responsible for the

construction, operation, and maintenance of the roadway improvements placed on County-owned property for the life of the easement. The specific area and space required for the non-exclusive easement to be granted to FDOT is cited in the easement document, and is described and shown in Exhibit "A."

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF A NON-EXCLUSIVE PERPETUAL EASEMENT, PURSUANT TO FLORIDA STATUTE SECTION 125.38, TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES, ACROSS COUNTY OWNED PROPERTY OPERATED BY THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, KNOWN AS THE METRORAIL SOUTH CORRIDOR (FOLIO # 03-4120-000-0031), WHICH IS ADJACENT TO AND WEST OF STATE ROAD 5/US HIGHWAY 1 (SOUTH DIXIE HIGHWAY) IN THE VICINITY OF GRANADA BOULEVARD; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXERCISE ANY AND ALL RIGHTS CONFEERED THEREIN

WHEREAS, this Board finds that, pursuant to Florida Statute Section 125.38, the State of Florida Department of Transportation intended use of the easement rights furthers the public interest and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the State of Florida Department of Transportation has made application to Miami-Dade County for the granting of easement rights; and

WHEREAS, this Board finds that the granting of easement rights would not interfere with any County purposes; and

WHEREAS, this Board approves the conveyance for the nominal consideration of \$10.00 pursuant to Florida Statute Section 125.38, of a non-exclusive Perpetual Easement in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the utilities and drainage structure proposed on Miami-Dade County property for this easement is in compliance with Resolution R-504-15, specifically, the placement of such shall have no negative aesthetic impact; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are adopted herein by reference.

Section 2. This Board authorizes the granting of a non-exclusive perpetual easement to the Florida Department of Transportation in substantially the form attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 3. This Board further authorizes the County Mayor, or the County Mayor's designee, to execute said easement for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, to take all actions necessary to effectuate same, and to exercise all provisions therein.

Section 4. Pursuant to Resolution R-974-09, this Board directs the County Mayor or the Mayor's Designee to record the easement conveyance accepted herein in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and to provide a recorded copy of the instrument to the Clerk of the Board within thirty (30) days of execution of said instrument; and directs the Clerk of the Board to attach and permanently store a recorded copy together with this resolution.

**PERPETUAL EASEMENT
(Public Purpose)**

THIS EASEMENT made this _____ day of _____, 20 _____, by MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, Grantor, to the STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION, its successors and assigns, Grantee.

WITNESSETH: That the Grantor for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other valuable considerations paid, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, hereby grants unto the Grantee, its successors and assigns, a perpetual easement for the transportation purposes further described below (the "Easement").

The Easement area is legally described as:

PARCEL 800

FIN.NO.433490-1

A Portion of the Miami-Dade Transit Metrorail Right of Way (formerly F.E.C. Railroad), lying in Section 19, Township 54 South, Range 41 East, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commence at the intersection of the South Line of the Southeast One-Quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 19, Township 54 South, Range 41 East and the Baseline of Survey of State Road 5(US1/South Dixie Highway) as shown on Florida Department of Transportation Right of Way Corridor Map for Section 87030 at Station 1296+87.25; thence N 47°48'14" E along said Baseline of Survey for a distance of 201.01 feet to Station 1298+88.26; thence N 42°11'46" W for a distance of 50.00 feet to a point on the Northwesterly Right of Way line of said State Road 5 being also the POINT OF BEGINNING of the following described parcel of land:

Thence S 47°48'14" W along said Northwesterly Right of Way line of said State Road 5 for a distance of 258.10 feet to a point of intersection with the projection to the Southeast of the existing northeasterly edge of pavement of Granada Boulevard, thence N 42°11'46" W along said existing northeasterly edge of pavement, for a distance of 36.53 feet; thence N 47°48'14" E, for a distance of 8.00 feet; thence S 42°11'46" E, for a distance of 2.81 feet, to the point of curvature of a curve concave to the North having a Chord Bearing of S 87°52'06" E; thence Easterly and Northerly along the arc of said curve, having a radius of 27.00 feet, through a central angle of 88°39'20", for a distance of 41.78 feet; thence N 47°48'14" E, for a distance of 185.78 feet; thence N 58°56'30" E, for a distance of 38.05 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

Containing 2,149 Square Feet of land, more or less (See EXHIBIT "A" also).

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said premises unto Grantee, subject, however, to the following conditions:

THAT this Easement is solely for the purpose of constructing, operating, and maintaining a roadway southbound right turn lane and related components as part of the referenced State Road (SR) 5 in Miami-Dade County, Florida and no other uses of the easement are permitted unless it is related to road or road improvements, or utility access. Grantor's use of the land subject to this Easement shall in no way interfere with Grantee's use of such land consistent with the rights set forth herein.

THAT In the event said transportation use is permanently discontinued or abandoned, Grantee's Easement shall terminate, title to the above described property shall immediately revert to the Grantor, and Grantor shall have the right to immediately possess same. If the Easement terminates at any time and Grantor deems it necessary to request the removal of the road's turning lane along with its improvements occupying the Easement Area, Grantee shall remove and restore the Easement Area to a like similar condition as existed prior to the Easement , at its sole cost and expense.

THAT Grantee shall not obstruct the county right-of-way located immediately above and underneath the Easement Area, except as may be required temporarily from time to time to effect the construction, inspection, maintenance, repairs, improvements and replacement of its road improvements. Any such work is subject to formal approval and permit by Grantor. Grantee shall promptly repair any damage to the Grantor's right-of-way, resulting from Grantee's exercising its rights hereunder.

To the extent provided by law, Grantee shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Grantor against any actions, claims, or damages arising out of, relating to, or resulting from negligent or wrongful act(s) of Grantee, or any of its officers, agents or employees, acting within the scope of their office or employment, in connection with the rights granted to or exercised by Grantee hereunder, to the extent and within the limitations of Section 768.28, Florida Statutes. The foregoing indemnification shall not constitute a waiver of sovereign immunity beyond the limits set forth in Florida Statutes, Section 768.28, nor shall the same be construed to constitute agreement by Grantee to indemnify Grantor for the negligent acts or omissions of Grantor, its officers, agents or employees, or for the acts of third parties. Nothing herein shall be construed as consent by Grantee to be sued by third parties in any manner arising out of this agreement.

THAT during construction, Grantee shall require its construction contractor(s) to maintain Commercial General Liability insurance providing continuous coverage for all work or operations performed under the Construction Contract. Such insurance shall be no more restrictive than that provided by the latest occurrence form edition of the standard Commercial General Liability Coverage Form (ISO Form CG 00 01) as filed for use in the State of Florida. The limits of coverage shall not be less than \$1,000,000 for each occurrence and not less than a \$5,000,000 annual general aggregate, inclusive of amounts provided by an umbrella or excess policy, or such other minimum insurance coverage that may be required by the Department for the construction of the Project, in accordance with the Department's Standards and Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction.

THAT this Easement is granted pursuant to Resolution No. _____ passed by the Miami-Dade Board of County Commissioners of the Miami-Dade County Florida records, a copy of which is attached herewith and forms part thereof.

THAT the provisions of this Easement may be enforced by all appropriate actions at law and in equity by the respective parties.

THAT Grantor makes no representations as to the title or condition of the property within the Easement Area or the suitability of the Easement Area property for the use intended hereunder.

The rights and obligations of the parties shall inure to the benefit of and be binding upon their respective successors and assigns.

This instrument may be amended or modified only by written instrument, executed and acknowledge by the parties hereto or their successors and assigns, and recorded in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County.






Dear Froilan:

The Florida Department of Transportation Operations' Office performed a Safety Study along SR5/US 1 from Yumuri Street to Granada Boulevard for the period of 2008 through 2010. Based on the three-year period 120 crashes occurred at the intersection of Granada Boulevard during the PM peak period. The abnormal crash types identified at the 95th percentile were rear end (83) collisions. Probable contributing causes for rear end crashes included careless driving and failing to stop in time for vehicle in front due to queue build-ups and overall heavy traffic congestion.

Based on the safety and operational deficiencies identified by this study the following is recommended:

- Repair damage pavement;
- Replace damaged sidewalk;
- Provide countdown pedestrian signal heads and "Do Not Block Intersection" signs at the approaches; and
- Provide an exclusive southbound right-turn lane to alleviate queue build-ups.

The Department requires a Perpetual Easement containing 2,759 square feet, more or less, for the above referenced project improvements which included the installation of a new southbound right-turn lane at SR 5/ US-1 and Granada Boulevard.




