Re: Contract Award Recommendation in the Amount of \$472,816.40 to Straight Ahead Construction, Inc. for the People's Transportation Plan Project Entitled Oleta River Culvert Extension; and Authorizing the Use of Charter County Transportation Surtax Funds for Such Purposes

The attached item was prepared by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW). **The Surtax impact is \$313,713.68.**

The attached contract is for culvert extensions for the proposed sidewalks along NE 209 Terrace and NE 214 Street, from NE 24 Court to NE 25 Court, located in Commission District 4. The scope of work consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment, and tools to perform all operations necessary to extend several culverts, and to add new sidewalks along a residential road that currently does not pass over the Oleta River. Work includes clearing, and grubbing, grading, channel excavation, guardrails, and the installation of sand-cement ripraps and sodding, as needed. This work will enhance the safety of the roadway and improve pedestrian facilities. The contract duration is established as 180-calendar days. This contract was competitively bid and reviewed for compliance and application of Community Small Business Enterprise (CSBE) program measures.

The fiscal impact is approximately \$472,816.40 and will be funded with Surtax Funds in the amount of \$313,713.68 and \$159,102.72 in Stormwater Utility Funds. This is an approved project and is referenced on page 69 of the FY 2015 Five Year Implementation Plan of People's Transportation Plan.

This item is scheduled for the June 15, 2016, Transit and Mobility Services Committee agenda, and is scheduled for the July 6, 2016, agenda of the Board of County Commissioners (BCC). If action is taken at the Transportation Trust Committee, this item will appear on the June 16, 2016, CITT Full Trust agenda. **(BCC Legislative File No. 161222)**





Recommendation

The attached Contract Award Recommendation for the People's Transportation Plan (PTP) project entitled *Oleta River Culvert Extension* (Project MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Request for Price Quotation (RPQ) No. 20150218) in the amount of \$472,816.40 to Straight Ahead Construction, Inc., was prepared by the Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) and is recommended for approval by the Board of County Commissioners (Board).

This Contract Award Recommendation is placed for Committee review pursuant to Miami-Dade County (County) Code Section 29-124(f). This Contract Award Recommendation may only be considered by the Board if the Citizens' Independent Transportation Trust (CITT) has forwarded a recommendation to the Board prior to the date scheduled for Board consideration or 45 days have elapsed since the filing with the Clerk of the Board of this contract award recommendation. If the CITT has not forwarded a recommendation and 45 days have not elapsed since the filing of this award recommendation, I will request a withdrawal of this item.

Scope

The work to be performed under this Contract includes culvert extensions for the proposed sidewalks along NE 209 Terrace and NE 214 Street, from NE 24 Court to NE 25 Court, which falls in Commissioner Sally A. Heyman's District 4.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact will be approximately \$472,816.40 and will be funded from the Charter County Transportation Surtax and the Stormwater Utility Fund. This figure includes the base contract amount of \$411,924.00, and contingency and dedicated allowance amounts. There is no fiscal impact to operations or maintenance.

The proposed improvements qualify under the allowable work categories included in the PTP Neighborhood Improvements Section. The funding index codes for this Project are CPEPTP704SDW and CPE316PWARTR (FY 2015-16 Adopted Capital Budget Project No.s 607800 and 6037700).

Delegation of Authority

No additional authority is being requested within the body of this Contract.

Track Record/Monitor

Straight Ahead Construction, Inc. has not performed any work for the County; however, staff confirmed and they have performed work for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) at a satisfactory level.

According to the Florida Department of State's, Division of Corporations, Straight Ahead Construction, Inc., Company Principals are: Mike MacDonell and Maria MacDonell, and the Company's address is listed as: 17800 SW 75 Avenue, Palmetto Bay, Florida, 33157.

Following DTPW's standard operating procedures after award of this Contract, a pre-construction meeting will be scheduled. The person responsible for all PTP projects in DTPW is Alejandro Martinez-Esteve, RA, LEED AP, Manager, Capital Improvements Section. Following completion of the award process, the project will be assigned to Leo Salgueiro, Project Coordinator, for the day-to-day responsibilities.

Background

As part of the PTP Neighborhood Improvements initiative, DTPW continues to take advantage of various contracting mechanisms, such as the Miscellaneous Construction Contracting (MCC) process available under the MCC 7360 Program. Through this process, DTPW forwards a RPQ by way of facsimile transmission to a pool of firms that have registered with Internal Services Department (ISD) for the respective trade. Additionally, DTPW advertises the project in the *Daily Business Review* and all solicitations are available on-line through the County portal under the "Procurement Solicitations" link. The project's award evaluation is based upon the bid submitted by the lowest responsive, responsible bidder for the project.

DTPW submitted its contract measure recommendation to ISD's Small Business Development Division (SBD) for Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation for this RPQ. SBD completed its Project Review and Analysis, and established a 7.90 percent SBE subcontractor goal. A Community Workforce Program Goal was deemed not applicable to this RPQ. On January 21, 2016, DTPW forwarded RPQ No. 20150218, utilizing the MCC 7360 Plan - CICC 7360-0/08 Contract, to a list of 456 pre-qualified firms. A total of five (5) firms purchased contract documents and eight (8) firms proffered a bid.

On February 24, 2016, Straight Ahead Construction, Inc. proffered the lowest responsive and responsible base bid of \$411,924.00, ten (10) percent over the County's cost estimate. The second lowest bidder, Maxon Groupe, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$442,006.60, 18 percent over the County's cost estimate. The third lowest bidder, Florida Construction and Engineering, Inc., proffered a base bid of \$465,912.97, 24 percent over the County's cost estimate.

Based on the result of the solicitation, DTPW issued a recommendation for award on March 8, 2016 for RPQ No. 20150218 to Straight Ahead Construction, Inc., with the stipulation that approval for this project must be obtained from the CITT and the Board. A copy of all bids and the bid tabulation for this project are available by contacting Alejandro Martinez-Esteve.

The work to be accomplished for this project consists of, but is not limited to, furnishing all supervision, labor, required materials, equipment, and tools to perform all operations necessary to extend several culverts, and to add new sidewalks along a residential road that currently does not pass over the Oleta River. Work includes clearing and grubbing, grading, channel excavation, guardrails, and the installation of sand-cement ripraps and sodding, as needed. This work will enhance the safety of the roadway and improve pedestrian facilities. The contract duration is established as 180 calendar days.
