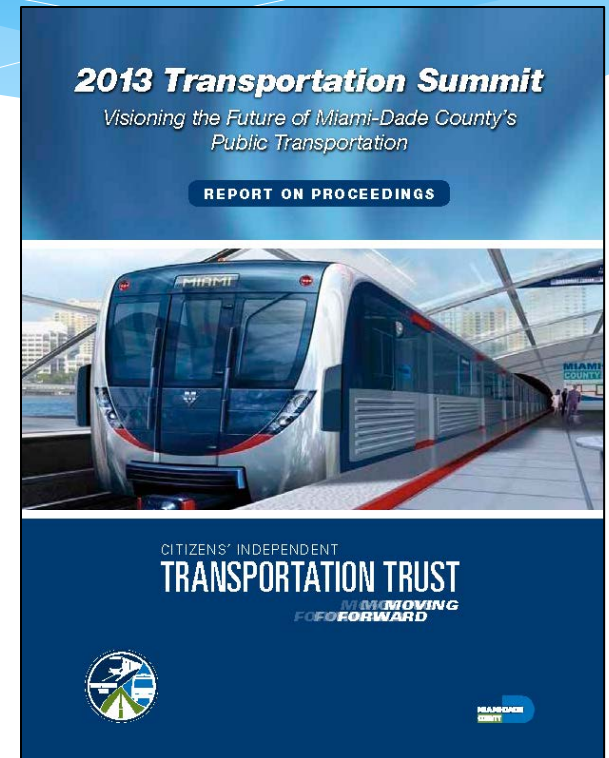

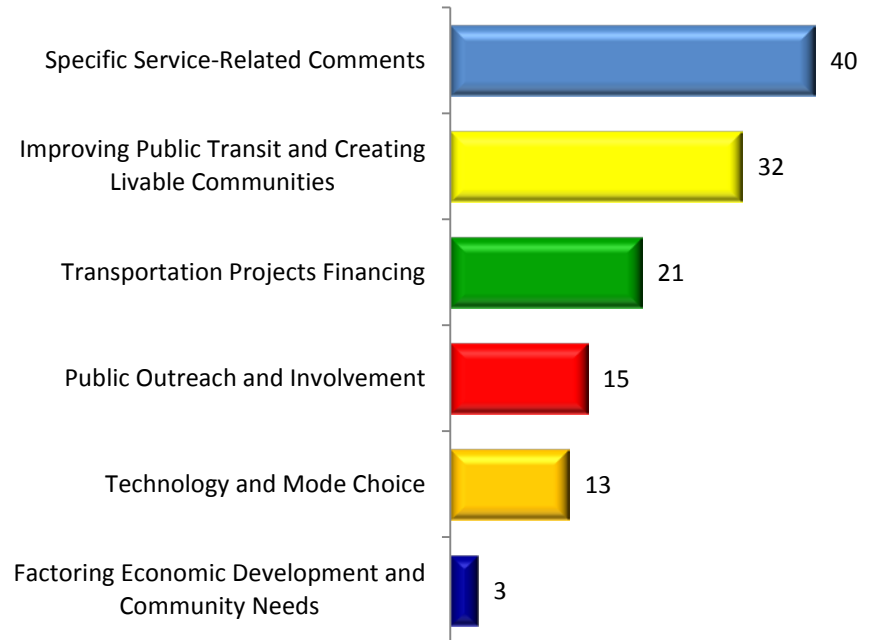

- * EasyCard use, weekend frequency, crowded vehicles

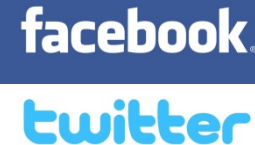
