

DERM comments on MPP

- Current definition of EXISTING FACILITY: An “existing marine facility” ...is one which was in use on October 28, 1984 or later, and if constructed after 1980, must have appropriate DERM permits...ALL EXISTING MARINE FACILITIES SHOULD BE ALLOWED TO CONTINUE WITH THE EXISTING USE, AND MAY RENOVATE...as long as there is no change in facility size, including no increase in number of wet or dry slips...”

- **EXISTING MARINE FACILITY definition issues**

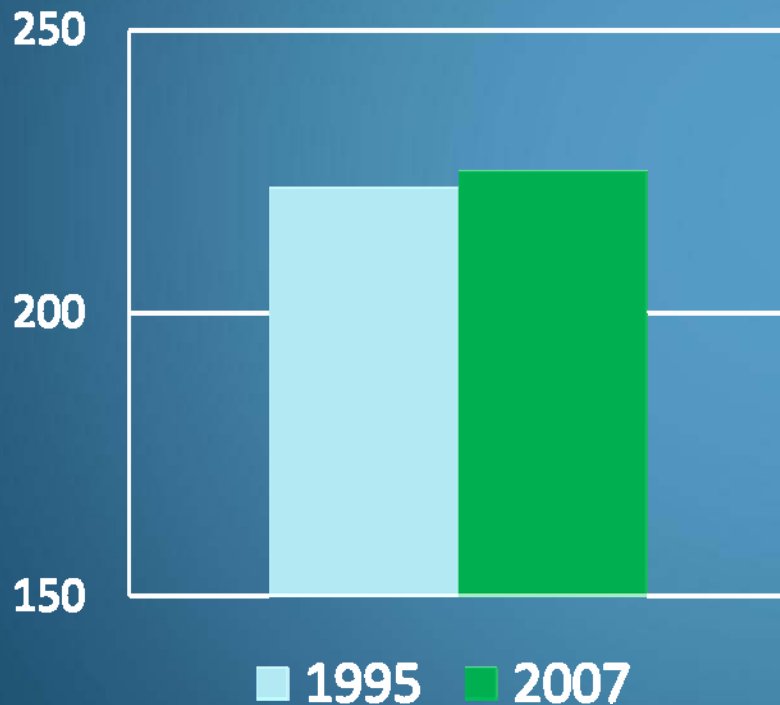
- October 28, 1984: increasingly difficult to document in-water use back more than 20 years
- October 28, 1984: a facility or slips that stopped operating a long time ago is NOT an existing impact
- Deals with a site, but does not address how to deal with a business relocating (a “fairness” issue)
- Need to define “existing use” more specifically, particularly with respect to power boats and categories of marine facilities

- **Clarification of narrative (not substance changes)**

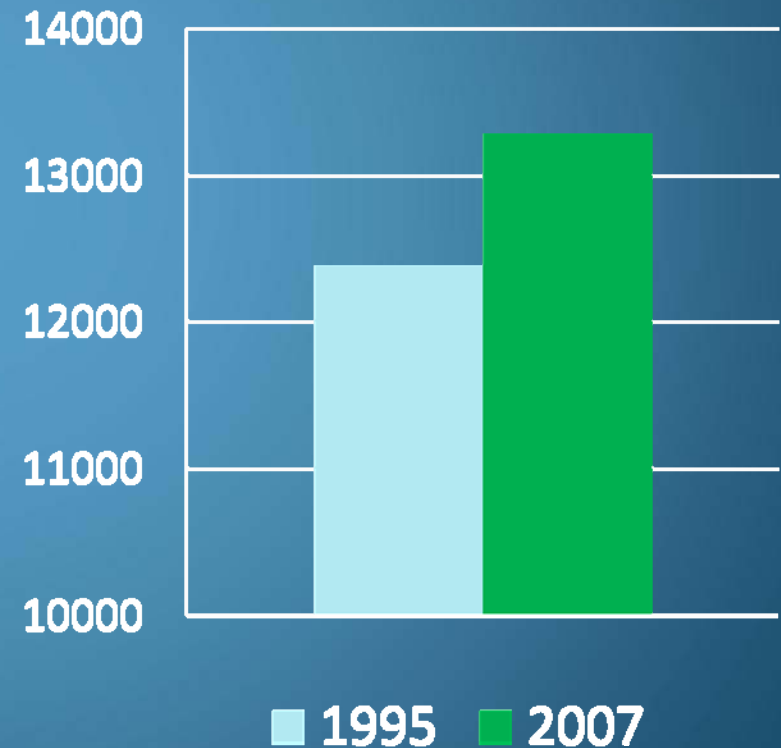
- Reformat entire section related to facility siting
- Add more background to explain potential concerns related to different types of facilities and boats
- Clarify “expansion criteria” paragraph
- Clarify “limited special use”, especially slip density
- Provide more context for “Performance Criteria” section
