ORDINANCE RELATING TO COMMISSION ON ETHICS AND PUBLIC TRUST; CREATING SECTION 2-1077 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSION ON ETHICS AND PUBLIC TRUST TO ENFORCE THE PUBLIC SERVICE HONOR CODE WHEN APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN THE FORM OF AN IMPLEMENTING ORDER; EMPOWERING THE COMMISSION ON ETHICS AND PUBLIC TRUST TO ISSUE LETTERS OF INSTRUCTION AND LETTERS OF REPRIMAND FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE HONOR CODE COMMITTED BY ELECTED COUNTY OFFICIALS AND ALL OTHER COUNTY OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES NOT SUBJECT TO THE ADMINISTRATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE MAYOR; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY, INCLUSION IN THE CODE, AND AN EFFECTIVE DATE (SEE AGENDA ITEM NO. 11A1)

* This Ordinance authorizes the Commission on Ethics and Public Trust to enforce the Public Service Honor Code. The Public Service Honor Code was approved by companion legislation on the same agenda (11A1).

RESOLUTION APPROVING RESTRICTIVE COVENANT IN FAVOR OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF STATE, DIVISION OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS, FOR A TERM OF TEN YEARS FOR THE USE, OPERATION, AND RENOVATION OF THE ADRIENNE ARSHT PERFORMING ARTS CENTER LOCATED AT 1300 BISCAYNE BOULEVARD, MIAMI, FLORIDA 33132; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE SAME FOR AND ON BEHALF OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY AND AUTHORIZING ITS RECORDATION IN THE PUBLIC RECORDS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY(Department of Cultural Affairs)

* This resolution allows the Adrienne Arsht Performing Arts Center (Arsht) to enter into a restrictive covenant with the State of Florida, requiring the facility to be used for cultural purposes for a period of 10 years. The Arsht needs the restrictive covenant in order to be eligible for a State grant to renovate the buildings protective exterior.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SOUTHEAST OVERTOWN/PARK WEST COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO ESTABLISH A CASH COLLATERALIZED LINE OF CREDIT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$75,000.00 WITH FLORIDA COMMUNITY BANK FOR THE REHABILITATION OF TOWN PARK PLAZA NORTH, TO ESTABLISH A DEPOSITORY ACCOUNT WITH FLORIDA COMMUNITY BANK TO SERVICE LINE OF AND PAY RELATED FEES NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.00(Office of Management and Budget)

* This resolution allows the Southeast Overtown/Park West Community Redevelopment Agency (SEOPW CRA) to establish a line of credit. The SEOPW CRA needs the line of credit to secure a grant in the amount of \$150,000 for the rehabilitation of Town Park North.
