Delivering for District 8: The Highlights from Year One



A Fair Share for South Dade

Commissioner Levine Cava partnered with Commissioner Moss to host the inaugural South Dade Solutions Summit: business, community and government leaders outlined a success plan for South Dade to improve transportation, economic development and quality of life. Recommendations include the County buying local food and products, promotion of “farm to table” dining, transit investments and greater marketing of our region’s unique assets. The plan will be our guiding document framing District 8’s agenda over the next three years.



Improving Transit Options

Commissioner Levine Cava championed the purchase of 60-foot super-capacity “bending” buses along the South Dade Busway: an important first step to provide commuters relief from congested routes and roadways. She also secured County support for “transit-oriented” development in Palmetto Bay with economic development funds, after dollars are recovered from stagnant projects.



Championing Our Parks & Environment

A coalition of engaged county residents partnered with Commissioner Levine Cava to help restore funding for our parks, with a 20% increase. Commissioner Levine Cava joined forces with Commissioner Sosa to combat Climate Change & Sea Level Rise with sensible approaches that put Miami-Dade on the forefront of this fight.



Expanding Economic Opportunity to Build an Economy that Works for All

Commissioner Levine Cava worked with economic development agencies to provide free workshops for South Dade businesses. The Small Business Academy provided training and tools to help local businesses overcome challenges. Commissioner Levine Cava also worked to increase access to area libraries by pressing for additional funding that restored an additional day of service for Coral Reef, Palmetto Bay, Naranja and Homestead branch libraries, and to restore vital police services. She also launched a program to bring area nonprofits together for training and technical assistance.



Increased Government Accountability & Responsiveness to Community Concerns

Commissioner Levine Cava passed the Employee Protection Ordinance to make it easier and safer for county employees to report fraud, waste and abuse. She also won passage of a bill that will use technology to make government information easier to access and use. She has brought vital information to area residents on all aspects of county decision-making including the budget.
