B-2 SPIRIT BOMBER SCHEDULED TO SOAR AT WINGS OVER HOMESTEAD AIR SHOW, NOV. 8

HOMESTEAD AIR RESERVE BASE, Fla. – The world’s most technologically advanced bomber is scheduled to pierce the skies over Homestead Air Reserve Base on Sunday, Nov. 8, during the two-day [Wings Over Homestead Air Show](#) on Nov. 7-8.

The [B-2 Spirit Bomber](#), also known as the stealth bomber, is multi-role bomber capable of delivering both conventional and nuclear munitions. The B-2 is operated and maintained out of Whiteman Air Force Base, Mo., and is capable of delivering massive firepower anywhere on the globe within hours through previously impenetrable defenses.

Other air show performers are the U.S Air Force Thunderbirds, F-15 Demonstration Team the GEICO Skytypers, Air Force Reserve Jet Car, U.S. Army Screaming Eagles Jump Team, and many other aerial demonstrations. Military aircraft including a KC-135 Stratotanker, Navy Airborne Warning and Control System (AWACS), F-16 Fighting Falcon, C-5 Galaxy, C-130 transport aircraft, and an Army H-60 helicopter will also be on public display.
