Back to School Tips

- Take an inventory of your child's closet and supply drawer. If you know what your child has, you don't have to spend money buying it again.
- Set a realistic budget and stick to it.
- Comparison shop through the Sunday newspaper advertising circulars. Prices can differ and you can save money on certain items.
- Ask your child for ideas. Your child has often collected information about prices and item quality from different sources.
- Remember school dress rules when buying clothing. Some schools have rules about the verbiage appearing on t-shirts. Shop around for the best uniform prices if your child's school requires them.
- Contact the school for bus schedules.
- Consider donating outgrown and gently used uniforms to local charities.
