Miami-Dade County/ Jackson Miracle Summer Internship Program

Jackson Health System is a unique institution, both in our community and in our country. We all take pride in supporting a taxpayer-owned system that employs some of the world's best caregivers and partners with the globally admired physicians of the University of Miami Miller School of Medicine. Many of Jackson's programs embrace its community mission in both clinical and non-clinical ways, and we are excited to announce we are again offering one of our signature initiatives in that tradition: the Miami-Dade County/ Jackson Miracle Summer Internship Program.

Health care is one of the most competitive and rewarding fields in the future economy, and it will certainly remain a backbone of our employment and growth in South Florida. The breadth and depth of work done at Jackson represents a learning opportunity that cannot be matched.

The internship is designed for Miami-Dade County residents, age 18 to 22, who are interested in exposure to career choices in hospital administration and operations. Many of the exceptional participants from last year's program have already been invited back.

The paid internship program offers a collaborative and innovative 9-week opportunity from **Monday, June 13th, through Friday, August 12th, 2016**. Intern candidates identified by your Commissioner and selected by Jackson will be paid \$10 an hour and will be required to participate during regular business hours for a 40 hour work week. On the job, they will be provided the opportunity to work on a variety of projects across the health system's hospitals and departments.

Candidates will be expected to pass both background checks and physical exams, and will be treated the same as employees, excluding benefits.


