ROADWAY RESURFACING CONTRACT
NW 119TH Street from NW 42ND Avenue
to NW 60TH Avenue

Project Description:

The project is located in the area of NW 119th Street from NW 42nd Avenue to NW 60th Avenue in Miami-Dade County Commission District 13. This project has been initiated to improve the roadway surface and driving conditions. The scope of work includes the following: milling and resurfacing, adjustment of valve boxes and manholes, ADA ramps and connectors, and pavement markings and signage.

Construction Schedule:

Construction is scheduled to begin on September 8, 2015 and is anticipated to be completed on January 6, 2016.

**The construction schedule above is weather permitting.*

Methodology and Efforts:

All efforts are being made to minimize the impact from construction activities to area residents, schools, businesses and motorists. The area will be restored to its original condition immediately upon the completion of construction activities. The restoration activities will address any areas impacted by the project, such as grassy areas, sidewalks and others items affected by the construction.

Property Appraiser TRIM Outreach Events




