MIAMI PREPARES FOR THE COPA AMERICANA MIAMI 2016 INTERNATIONAL YOUTH SOCCER TOURNAMENT!

Final preparations under way for the Copa Americana Milan Junior Miami 2016 International

Soccer Tournament for U10, U12, U14, U16, U18 boys categories.

The International tournament will kick off at Amelia Earhart Park from June 24 to 26, 2016. 10 Milan Junior Elite International Teams featuring 165 players from 16 countries in the Americas, will arrive on Jun 21 to begin pre tournament training and teams' retreat at Barry University, as well as a College Combine (June 23<sup>rd</sup>) that has been scheduled as part of this international event.

Over 1,000 participants and 48 teams arriving from Aruba, Bonaire, Curaçao, Colombia, Honduras, Puerto Rico, Dominican Republic, USA, Peru, Ecuador, Canada, Venezuela among other nations that will have the opportunity to measure their style of play and share their cultural and ethnical heritage with that of players from numerous nations, making this tournament a truly exciting exchange of sport and cultural experiences.

The event will also feature the Copa Americana Milan Junior 2015 champions in all categories. These teams will be traveling from South America and looking to defend their Championship titles.

2016 tournament champions will have the opportunity earn the "No Pay To Play" program prize, which enables winners to participate in the Copa Americana Pereira 2016, October 14-16, 2016 in Pereira, Colombia.

The Copa Americana Milan Junior Miami 2016 will kick-off with an Olympic style ceremony parade at Marlins Park Stadium during the Marlins vs Chicago Cubs game on Thursday, June 23<sup>rd</sup>.

The Copa Americana is expected to bring in over one Million Dollars in positive economic impact to Miami-Dade and is focused on generating environmental awareness in the community. The event will abstain from the use of plastic bottles, disposables and packaging and will promote environmentally friendly alternatives to reach this important goal.



## How to Start a Neighborhood Watch group to deter crime

Neighborhood Watch members learn when to call police about a suspicious person or vehicle

They set up a phone chain in the neighborhood

Police: Don't intervene if you see a crime in progress. Let them handle it.

Starting a Neighborhood Watch is not hard but it takes dedication for it to work properly. Since I have had lots of requests lately, let me share how we have been doing it for the last 40 years.

- 1.** When a resident calls our office - Citizens' Crime Watch of Miami-Dade - we take a request for service, listing all their information and concerns. This way, we forward them to the appropriate law enforcement department crime prevention unit or neighborhood resource officers.
- 2.** The Neighborhood Watch meetings, which last about an hour, are held usually at 7 p.m. weekdays.
- 3.** The meeting preferably is held at someone's home in the neighborhood. In some areas, this may not be possible because of crime issues, so we try to find a safe location nearby - a church, a clubhouse or in some cases, the middle of the street. For those who live in apartment buildings, we have held meetings in parking lots.
- 4.** Once a meeting date has been established with the police officer and the host, a flier and brochure are distributed to neighbors. English, Spanish and Creole versions are available.
- 5.** The night of the meeting, the police officer and someone from my office attends. The officer provides information regarding crime trends, crime statistics, his role as a community officer and what his department is doing to assist the community.

He also discusses alarm issues, as well as how and when to call the police. The officer teaches residents what information is needed when calling police about a suspicious person or vehicle, including what to do and not do. The officer always tells residents who see a crime in progress or suspicious person not to intervene. That is for the police to do.

- 6.** Our coordinator explains how to set up a phone chain - a collection of phone numbers, addresses and special needs or information pertinent to their homes. When the phone chain is completed, it is shared with all neighbors participating in the crime watch. This is the most crucial part of Neighborhood Watch because it's how everyone stays in touch. Once the Neighborhood

Watch is organized, we provide Crime Watch signs, house stickers and T-shirts, at no cost to anyone since we are funded by your tax dollars.

Implementing a Neighborhood Watch is not easy. It takes dedication and "sweat equity," but as the thousands already involved note, it's the best thing that can happen to a neighborhood.

The above steps may differ for some municipalities that implement their own programs. At the local and national level, properly trained Neighborhood Watch members do not "patrol," do not carry "weapons," and do not "intervene" at any time. They are strictly law enforcement's "eyes and ears."

The Senior Companion Program offers friendship and assistance to other older Americans who are homebound and need an extra helping hand to live independently in their own homes. Senior Companions make the lives of those they serve less lonely through their friendship, education, provision of community resources, and regular friendly visits. Thanks to the efforts of Senior Companions, many older adults are able to avoid institutionalization and can lead more happy fulfilling lives in their own homes.

### **Benefits of Community Volunteer Service Participation:**

- The Senior Companion serves 20-40 hours a week.
- Senior Companion Program is open to income eligible individuals age 55 and over. In return for their service, Senior Companions receive a stipend of \$2.65 an hour, reimbursement for transportation, and a monthly training.
- Participation in volunteer program does not affect any of your social security benefits, food stamps or government housing.
- 40 hour pre-service orientation & education training.
- The volunteers annually are recognized for years of service and participate in community events

### FDOT Autonomous Vehicle Day



Commissioner Esteban Bovo, Jr. and the Board of County Commissioners joined the Florida Department of Transportation for an autonomous vehicle exhibition. At the exhibition FDOT demonstrated how the vehicle drives, performs, and provides data to build "smart roads." The vehicle was designed and built by Embrey Riddle University in partnership with FDOT to study the impacts of autonomous vehicles on the roads. The information collected will be used to construct "smart roads" which will be capable of handling autonomous vehicles.

The project suffered a shortage of funding when the state was unable to deliver the necessary funds. The project connects the existing Tri-Rail lines to Downtown Miami into the new Brightline station being constructed next to the Government Center. This new station will connect Metrorail, Metromover, Metrobus, Tri-

Rail, and Brightline all together in one grand station. Once the project is completed commuters from the northern parts of the Miami-Dade County as well as from Broward County will be able to use Tri-Rail to get directly to Downtown Miami.


