Identify homeless hot spots (transit, parks, law enforcement, libraries)

Establish count teams (including volunteers)

> Assign zone/areas assignments

Train teams using mobile application

#### HOMELESS CENSUS Enumerating Homeless Persons Biannually

- Sheltered (Emergency Shelter, Transitional Housing, Safe Haven, Domestic Violence Facility
- Unsheltered (Places Not Meant for Human Habitation
  - Street
  - Car
  - Park
  - Abandoned Building
  - Bus or Train Station
  - Airport
  - Campground



# CENSUS 2020 Enumerating Vulnerable Populations

- Creation of Continuum of Care (CoC) Census 2020 Working Group (July 2019)
- Representation from outreach, emergency shelter, permanent housing, domestic violence, veterans and youth)
- Assist in identifying strategies to ensure that homeless and formerly homeless households in our continuum are counted.
