NOTES

- 1 Only Clerk, A/C, ES, and ATS will be asked to do "Pre-Election Set-Up."
- 2 Only one (1) Inspector or (1) Poll Deputy will be asked to do "Post-Election Set-Up."
- 3 ES will get \$5.00 flat fee for mileage to pay for driving to Collection Center if personal car is used.
All poll workers will receive a flat rate of \$ 5.00 for mileage if they are assigned to work outside home Precinct.
- 4 If Standby is not called by noon, poll worker will be paid \$18.55 + \$40.00 for Implementation Training (if applicable).
If Standby is called and chooses not to work, poll worker will **ONLY** get paid \$ 40 for Implementation Training (if applicable).
If Standby is called and arrives at Precinct to work within one hour, poll worker will be paid his/her regular Election Day pay (depending on position) + \$40.00 for Implementation Training (if applicable).

If any poll worker leaves early, poll worker will receive a flat rate of \$50 as Election Day pay in addition to \$ 40.00 for Implementation Training and Pre- Election Set-Up Pay (if applicable).
