<b>County Court Judge</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>No earlier than noon of the 120th day, and no later than noon of the 116th day, before the primary election [F.S. 105.031(1)]</i>	Noon, Monday, May 2, 2016 through Noon, Friday, May 6, 2016
<b>School Board Member</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>No earlier than noon of the 71st day, and no later than noon of the 67th day, before the primary election [F.S. 105.031(1)]</i>	Noon, Monday, June 20, 2016 through Noon, Friday, June 24, 2016
<b>County Commissioner</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>No earlier than the 84th day and no later than noon on the 70th day prior to the date of the election at which he/she is a candidate [Miami-Dade County Charter, Article 3, Section 3.04, A]</i>	8:00 am, Tuesday, June 7, 2016 through Noon, Tuesday, June 21, 2016
<b>Mayor</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>No earlier than the 84th day and no later than noon on the 70th day prior to the date of the election at which he/she is a candidate [Miami-Dade County Charter, Article 3, Section 3.04, A]</i>	8:00 am, Tuesday, June 7, 2016 through Noon, Tuesday, June 21, 2016
<b>Property Appraiser</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>No earlier than noon on the 84th day and no later than noon on the 68th day prior to the date of the election at which he or she is a candidate. [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Part III, Chapter 2, Article VII, Section 2-69(c)]</i>	Noon, Tuesday, June 7, 2016 through Noon, Thursday, June 23, 2016
<b>Community Council</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>No earlier than the 72nd day and no later than noon on the 70th day prior to the date of the election at which he or she is a candidate [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Part III, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(4)]</i>	8:00 am, Monday, June 20, 2016* through Noon, Tuesday, June 21, 2016
<b>South Dade Soil and Water Conservation District</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>Between noon of the 71st day prior to the primary election and noon of the 67th day prior to the date of the primary election [F.S. 99.061(3)]</i>	Noon, Monday, June 20, 2016 through Noon, Friday, June 24, 2016
<b>Community Development District</b> <i>(Nonpartisan)</i>	<i>Between noon of the 71st day prior to the primary election and noon of the 67th day prior to the date of the primary election [F.S. 99.061(3)]</i>	Noon, Monday, June 20, 2016 through Noon, Friday, June 24, 2016

\* Since the date falls on a Sunday, it has been moved to the next business day.

### **Candidates Qualifying with the State Division of Elections:**
