# Miami-Dade County 2020 Community Council Member Candidate Qualifying Information

Due to the current state of emergency and the guidance limiting person-to-person contact to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus, an emergency rule relating to candidate qualifying was filed. Read <u>Rule No. 1SER20-1</u> for more information. As a result of this rule, Miami-Dade County candidates may submit their qualifying documents in PDF format at <u>gualifyingdocuments@miamidade.gov</u>. The qualifying fee can be mailed or hand delivered to our office located 2700 NW 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Miami, FL 33172.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:** [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(1)]

- 1. Resident elector of Miami-Dade County for at least three (3) years.
- 2. Resident elector of Council Area for at least six (6) months prior to qualifying.
- 3. Resident elector of the Subarea for at least three (3) months prior to qualifying.

Note: At the time of qualifying, candidates shall submit proof of residency for the prescribed period. Proof of residency shall establish that the qualifying candidate has met the residency requirements for the required period. No council member shall be employed by Miami-Dade County or be a member of the Board of County Commissioners.

ELECTION AREA: Community Council Subarea [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(1)]

### TERM:

Four (4) years [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(2)]

The term of Council Members shall commence on the second Tuesday next succeeding the date provided for the General Election. (November 17, 2020) [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(3)]

SALARY: All Council Members shall serve without compensation but shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties, upon approval of the County Commission. [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(D)]

ELECTION DATES: August 18, 2020 – Primary [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(3) and F.S. 100.061]

> November 3, 2020 – General (only in case of a tie) [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(6) and F.S. 100.031]

QUALIFYING DATES: 8:00 a.m., Monday, June 8, 2020, through Noon, Tuesday, June 9, 2020 [Miami-Dade County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 20, Article IV, Section 20-43(A)(4)]

A qualifying office may accept and hold qualifying papers submitted not earlier than 14 days prior (May 25, 2020) to the beginning of the qualifying period to be processed and filed during the qualifying period. [F.S. 99.061(8)] {*Please note that our office will be closed on May 25 in observance of Memorial Day.*}
