- Can be used for medications not covered under your formulary;
- Can be used in the Medicare Part D coverage gap (donut hole).

What is a prescription drug discount card?

Discount prescription cards (also known as “consumer cards” and “100% copay cards”) allow prescription drug users to save money on all types of prescription medications. At the time of purchase, cardholders simply present their card at a participating pharmacy to instantly receive substantial discounts on their prescription medications. *It's that easy.*



How do Discount prescription cards work?

Discount prescription cards contain special computerized instructions that can be read by the pharmacy's computer, similar to an ATM card. When the card information is entered, the price on the prescription is discounted based on the pharmacy's agreement with their pharmacy benefit manager. This type of cutting-edge technology allows consumers to save money without encountering any difficulties at the checkout line.

Who needs a prescription drug discount card?

Any individual with limited or no prescription drug coverage benefits from a prescription drug discount card. Instead of paying full price for medication, cardholders can save money whenever they purchase prescription medications. People who already have insurance coverage may still find the card useful, as it can discount medications that are not covered by their healthplan.

Ways you can save money with the America's Drug Card prescription drug discount card, even if you have insurance:

● Formularies

Insurance companies are increasingly limiting which medications they will pay for such as: birth control, diabetic supplies, smoking cessation and medications that they decide are not cost-effective for them.

● High Deductible plans

Our discount prescription card allows you to get discounts on prescription medications before you reach the level at which the insurance company starts paying benefits.

● Medicare Part D

Our discount prescription drug card can be used to secure discounts on those medications that are excluded from Part D Medicare. It will also provide discounts when a person on Medicare reaches the coverage gap or “donut hole”.

● High co-payment

When you have a co-pay that is higher than the retail cost of the drug, use the discount card and pay the lesser retail price.

2. Use the card at a participating pharmacy.
