Enrique Chía was born in Cienfuegos, Cuba, and emigrated to the United States in 1961. He studied piano in his native Cienfuegos and earned a Ph.D. in metallurgy at the Georgia Institute of Technology. Nominated for a Grammy Award in 2001, he has recorded more than 50 albums of instrumental music on the piano, accompanied by other instruments. He has performed widely in the United States and internationally, especially throughout Latin America.
