Said Board Order granted the former owner an extension of time to comply with the requirements of Sections 24-43.1(7) and 24-43.3(2)(q) of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida to allow an existing motel to continue to be served by an on-site drinking water supply well and a septic tank while public water and public sanitary sewers abut the subject site. The current property owner is requesting an indefinite extension of time to comply with the above-referenced Code sections in addition to Sections 24-43.1(4) and 24-43.1(6) of the Code, allowing the existing motel to exceed the maximum sewage loading limits within the Code. The subject property is located at 26480 South Dixie Highway, Miami-Dade County, Florida.

The request is to allow the continued use of the property that builds custom wooden forms and for the storage and maintenance of cranes, trucks, and various other associated vehicles belonging to the facility. The use generates a liquid waste other than domestic sewage and the property is served by public water without public sanitary sewers. The subject property is located at 327 S.W. 2nd Avenue, Florida City, Florida.
- ERNESTO MORALES Request for a variance from the requirements of Section 24-48.3 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The request is to allow the placement of a piling in a location where water depths are less than the required four (4) foot water depth at mean low water.
